Chair Report – 10/20/07

Good Morning West Valley,

I was asked to contact Maryvale Hospital about our room reservation to see if we could make some time to have a GSR Orientation before each Area meeting. I got hold of Connie in Administration and she confirmed that we have this room from 8am to 2pm. As it stands, our H & I Subcommittee meets here from 8:30am to 9:30am and then Area starts at 10am. If we wanted to try to work in a GSR Orientation, we could possibly bump H & I back to 8am, ending at 9am, so we could have orientation from 9:30am to 10am. I'll get with Branden, our RCM whose currently handling GSR Orientation, and Jeff T., our H & I Chair, to see what they want to do. I also went ahead and reserved this conference room for 2008 on the 3rd Saturday of each month. Note that next month we will be meeting out in the dining room with the piano again because they need this room for something else.

* I talked to the Regional Web servant about getting some more documents put on the regional website. I submitted our literature order form, motion form and statement of willingness to him, so those should be out there now as well as our guidelines. As far as getting our monthly minutes put on, he said he could do it no problem, but asked me to redact the document before giving it to him. I asked what the hell redaction was and he said it is basically editing the document and removing or blacking out personal information, such as last names and phone numbers. I hadn't even really thought about the issue of privacy and anonymity regarding this, so I held off until coming back here to confirm with the group before posting it. What he's seen in other areas is things like the secretary will just go through the minutes before mailing them to him and mark out with a fat, black marker things like last names, bank account numbers and personal addresses. People can also request of the secretary that their phone number be blocked out. The secretary will often get with the person whose info is in question to ask them what they want as well. My thinking is we'll run with that unless anyone has a problem with it. Is everyone okay with that or should we have further discussion on it in open sharing?

I worked on putting the budgets together this month. I'd like to thank Jeff T., our H&I Chair, who was the only person who gave me his budget without me calling. I'm going to pass out a spreadsheet with all the proposed budgets on it for this next fiscal year. I'll entertain a motion submitted to accept the budgets, which we'll address in new business. We still haven't received our annual treasurer report, which is a breakdown of all expenses last fiscal year. It was due at last Area from the last Treasurer and I spoke to him then about getting it done. It still isn't done, so I'll offer up my help with it this coming month or if we get a new Treasurer, he might do it. Either way, that document would be helpful with budget approval, but that's up to this body if you want to wait until next month to approve budgets.

I have been given the Outreach 'box', which has some Outreach information and some literature in it. Since we don't currently have an Outreach Subcommittee, and haven't for a few years, I am going to turn all the inventory items over to our Literature Chair to put in stock. That way it can be useful and not sitting around getting outdated or messed up. I also asked Tracey K., our Literature Chair, to develop a new group literature 'startup-kit' and she worked up a set for about \$30. I'm submitting this budget on behalf of Outreach, expecting that we might get a request for a kit about every other month, or about 6 per year. So you'll see that on the budget proposal. Please keep in mind that we are still looking for an Outreach Chair. This position only requires 2 years of clean time and one year of Outreach experience. Please put the word out in your meetings. Also, meeting list changes can be submitted to myself, Robert S., Kevin U. or the regional website online.

I've also turned my PO Box key over to our Secretary today. (WILL DO THIS MONTH)

That's it for now. Thank you for letting me be of service to this Area.



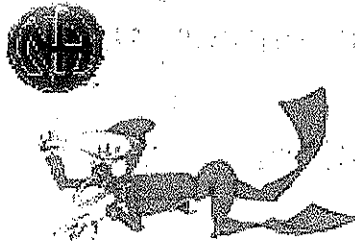
