## AREA CHAIR REPORT

Good Morning,

We put the October minutes on the regional website as a test run and it was successful. You can find them at [www.arizona-na.org](http://www.arizona-na.org) under Service – Documents and Forms – West Valley. I redacted the document, but only saw a couple of things, like last names, that I blacked out. Hopefully, this will allow us to save some postage and mailing costs. I'll use the set of minutes sent to me to lend to the Regional webservant to get them posted on the website. In the future, when I'm not here, they'll need to be mailed to the webservant to get posted. I think we should contact the other valley areas to let them know the minutes will be on the website if they want them. I'm going to ask that Tonya take care of that. We should still mail a copy to World Services, since that was their request.

I worked up the Annual Treasurer Report for the 2006-2007 fiscal year and I'll hand them out now, along with the updated proposed operational budgets. We had decided last month to table approving budgets until we had the annual treasurer report complete for reference. The next step in the budget approval process is for you all to take a look at the report and the budget and decide if you want to submit a motion to approve the proposed budgets. I would suggest that questions about budget figures can be addressed to the officer or the subcommittee chair when they are giving their report, so keep that in mind as we're going through our reports this morning.

We also tabled the annual prudent reserve approval, which is a new process beginning this year. Burt calculated that the average monthly expenses for last year were \$2,014.00, so he recommended a new prudent reserve of \$2050.00. Our prudent reserve is currently \$1,150.00 plus Activities prudent reserve of \$700.00 for a total of \$1,850.00. This means it's a proposed increase of \$200.00. I think we also should address whether we need to have both a prudent reserve and all the various 'Funds on Hold' as we've been doing on our Treasurer report. I have set some time aside in Open Sharing for discussions on prudent reserve and budget, in case that is needed.

I went to the Helpline meeting this month, since we don't have a liaison and that I'll report that separately.

I held onto the PO Box key this month because we had paid the box late and therefore the box was locked. I believe it's all resolved and I'll let Burt report on that. I just wanted to report that I'll be giving the key to Tonya this month instead of last month.

This is an open letter to the Narcotics Anonymous activities chairperson for each of the four areas in and around Phoenix, Arizona, from their fellow trusted servants on the Nalloween committee:

Dear fellow members of N.A.,

As you may already know the Nalloween committee is a unique committee consisting of a group of dedicated N.A. members that band together for two months a year for the sole purpose of providing the fellowship with an activity for the Halloween season. The committee is unique in the fact that it disbands after the event and, after serving the individual member of Narcotics Anonymous, serves four (the West, Phoenix, East and South Central) area service committees.

This has been a popular event, well supported, and has been a benefit to our Narcotics Anonymous community in the past years. The event was hosted by the West Valley area in 2005, the Phoenix area in 2006, the East Valley area in 2007, and will be hosted by our newest area, the South Central, in 2008.

Recently some concerns have been raised about the governing and accountability of the committee. As a group we are anxious to comply with the requirements of our fellow members in their capacity as trusted servants for their area service groups, and we take very seriously our charge to be of service to our most important member, the individual member of Narcotics Anonymous.

Most of the criticism this committee faces is from the calendar year of 2006 when an equal share of the money made by the event was sent to the new South Central area in spite of the fact that they had not participated financially in sponsoring the event. This decision was made by the committee with all the best intentions of helping a new area of N.A. get on it's feet. We clearly recognize the fact that we over stepped our authority to disperse these funds in this manner and have adapted an equal in equal out policy until and unless directed otherwise by the collective group conscience we answer to. It is only fair to point out that all money is accounted for and our decision was made in full belief that our fellowship would support our effort to help our newest members.

Two other concerns brought before our committee were that we open a bank account and formulate guidelines to operate under. Opening a bank account would not be good stewardship of the funds entrusted to us by the fellowship because we only use them for part of the year and would be paying service charges for the entire year. We feel that we are in compliance with these two issues by operating under the direction of the hosting area activities committee, following their guidelines and using their bank account for the short duration of our existence. We invite input and constructive assistance, we appreciate being held to accountability, and most importantly we are highly dedicated to our primary purpose of carrying the message of recovery to the addict who still suffers.
