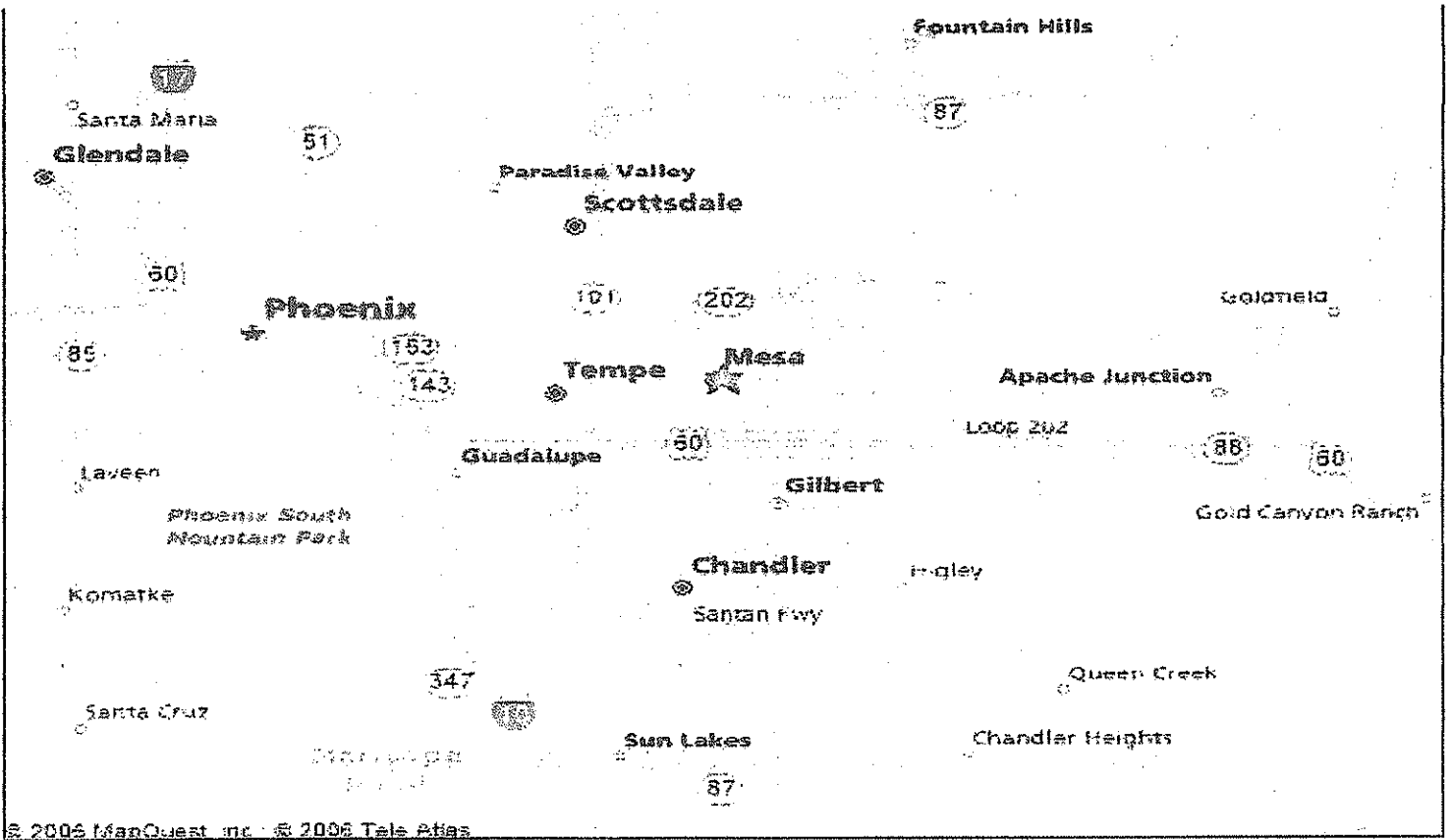

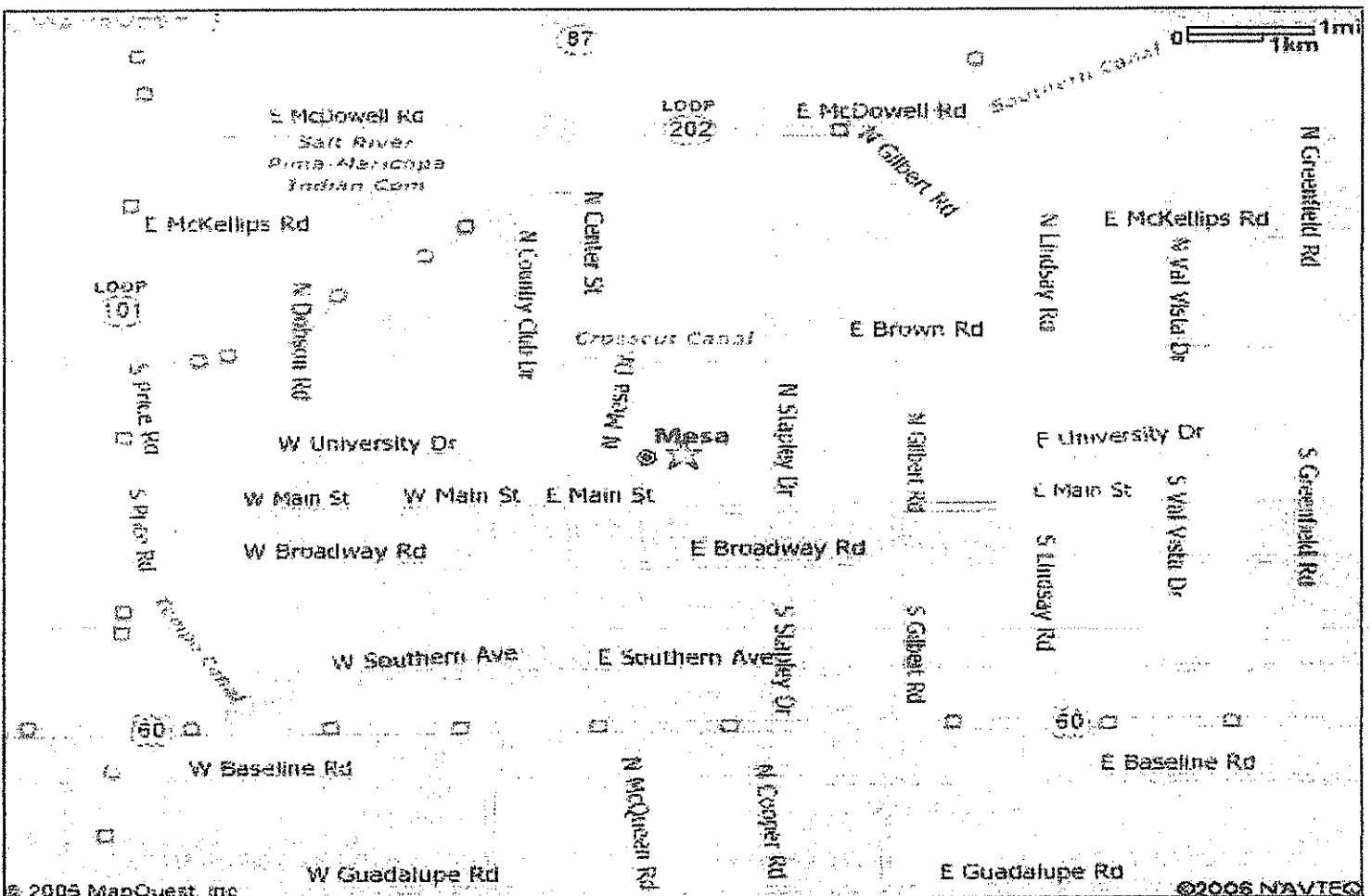

Good Morning West Valley,


VICE CHAIR REPORT
