## Subcommittee Guideline Review Ad-hoc Committee Report 20080301

Hi everyone,

Draft 13 of the revised PASC guidelines was distributed with the agenda and minutes this month. I also sent a PDF to our Regional Webservant last Saturday, but it apparently hasn't been posted yet.

I really can't assume that homegroups have had an opportunity to review the latest draft at this point. The electronic version should have gone out in time for every homegroup's business meeting, but I may have contributed to a delay in the mailing to where the same can't be said of the hard copy. Maybe this is why I've had very little feedback thus far. Micheal gave me some great input on draft 11, and this draft reflects some changes he brought to light including modifications to the Helpline guidelines reflecting the absence of the bank account and Treasurer (after bouncing them off of David and taking his input as well).

We still need to address the Narathon guidelines, since the meeting that we hoped would allow us to develop something about the requirements and duties of the trusted servants was canceled due to a funeral. Since then, an idea was proposed to rewrite the Narathon guidelines based on a draft set of convention guidelines that share a lot in common with the Narathon of today, but that's really up to a Narathon Committee that has yet to be formed for the coming year. It's important to note that this committee runs from February to February, and they need a new Chairperson. I believe they want this position to be open to anyone with the appropriate level of experience in the greater Phoenix metropolitan area. Since they don't define any other requirements, the PASC subcommittee chair requirements apply. Once a new subcommittee is formed, I'd really like to attend a meeting or two to see if there's a consensus around an approach to revising their guidelines. If I can enlist Jeff's help, I'm hopeful that we can come up with something useful and merge them into the PASC guidelines in short order.
