On March 24, 2008 an audit of the Narathon Committee was preformed. In attendance was vice chair Joey, chair Chris, Secretary Michael, and Narathon treasurer Penny and the new Narathon treasurer Trent.

The audit team would like to thank the Narathon treasurer and committee for their service and dedication. We were please to find that their procedures and documentation was in perfect order.

The audit included a detailed examination of all the activities for the Month of December 2007. The audit team looked at the Expense, Income and Cash Summary statement and detailed paper trail and backup for each account. We found no errors and were able to find backup documentation for every entry in their Checking account and the monthly Cash Summary statement.

The audit team would like to recommend that the check register be included with the transfer of documentation to members of the committee. A check register was missing; however the Monthly Cash Summary statement was able to provide the detail of a check register. The team also recommended that there be a notation for the income from multiple sources be documented on the monthly statement. We found a detailed backup for each deposit however the Cash Summary statement would benefit by including this information on the statement.
