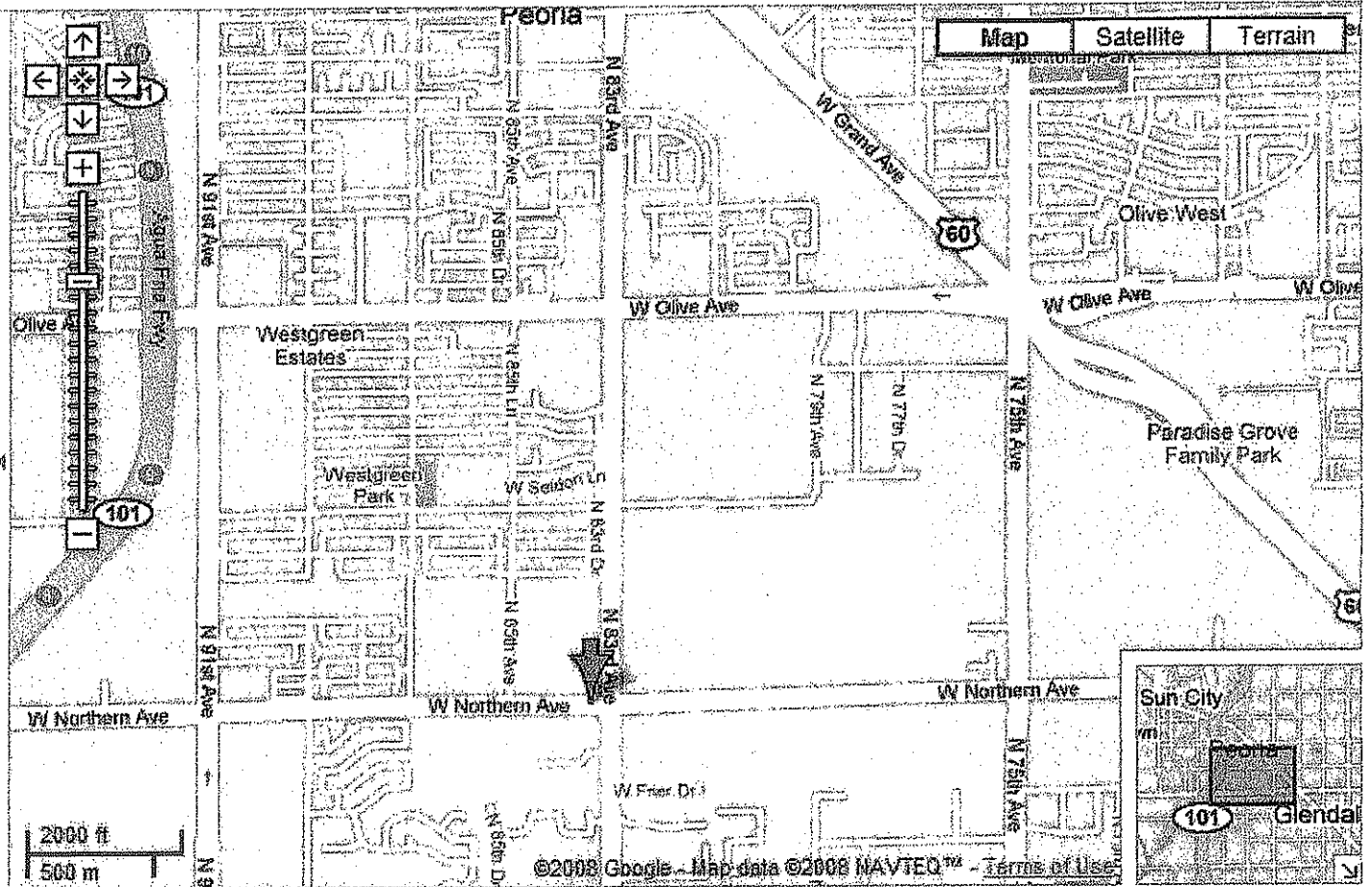

P & P ADMINISTRATOR REPORT**

Good Afternoon GRS of West Valley Area. I want to apologize for not being here at Area for two months. I was not here in February due to illness, and I was out of town in March.

There were **two motions given** to me to review.

The first was from 1/12/08(even though the motion form has date as 1/12/07) the maker was KISS, seconded by GLOB. This motion called for the area to adopt a "Fund Flow Policy." In "A Guide To Local Services" page 64, under Area Budgeting. 2nd paragraph "Narcotics Anonymous groups directly support area, regional, and world services from money left over after covering their own expenses. Area committees, after setting money aside to cover budgeted expenses, are encouraged to do the same with their surplus funds, sending it on to the other levels of the service structure."

Current policy provides the following;

page 3 under Functions D.2. With a prudent reserve (emergency fund) of \$1,150.00 and operational budget to be determined annually at audit.

page 12 B. Operational Expenses: Discusses how to come up with a operation expenses from prior monthly expenses. (There have been discussions at this committee that would suggest that this guidelines need some updating because of operating changes that have taken place.)

Therefore in looking at this motion and its intent to be financially accountable to groups for donations, it should state to **establish fund flow policy.**

Regarding where to add this procedure in Area Policy and Procedures it would be under **Treasurer Duties: P. At the close of business for the months that Arizona Regional Meeting is held, all money above (or left over) our ER Funds and Operational Budget which is WVA current Prudent Reserve shall be sent on as SWA Regional Fund Flow Donation.**

The second was from 2-1-08 in which the motion itself is not clear. Explanation: this motion states that there is seasonal volatility of donations to area. Below is the donations for last year.

It would appear that Apr-Aug were the larger donations.

Area's Operating Expenses are at \$2050.00 per motion 5/11/07. If we look at the Prudent Reserve (I use this term carefully) and our monthly donations then we will only be sending surplus funds and therefore we are being financially responsible. The motion stated that we have summer shortfall... the facts are we have larger donations during the summer. To only make donations in only the months they meet is address in first motion.

I read this motion a number of times and it looks like the it calls the *area to establish an operating fund in addition to prudent reserve of one months average operating expenses as a hedge against our regular shortage.*

At this time Policy and Procedures defines the Prudent Reserve to be \$1,150.00 plus Operating Expenses (the monthly average of prior years expenses) from what I can see this is not what the Prudent Reserve is at this time.

In addition this motion has no intent.

Therefore the P&P recommendation is a **substitute motion** to correct the prudent reserve from **\$2050.00(Operational Expenses) plus \$1,150.00(ER Funds) for a Total of \$3200.00.**

I would further recommend that **Prudent Reserve be defined as prior year average monthly donation plus subcommittee monthly proposed budgets.** This recommendation is because at this time Area's monthly donations are not equal to monthly expenses, and the area does not utilize and might be better served by using propose budgets rather than prior year expenses, because of proposed budget increases can not be taken into consideration using current procedure.

Not to complicate the situation as P&P Administrator it is my recommendation that the Area look at the bigger picture and clarify policy and procedures that look at establishing **Prudent Reserve** in Policy & Procedures with a clear definition. This would be as simple as directing this trusted servant to provide the committed with the information from Policy & Procedures and recommendations to help clarify the areas that discuss **Prudent Reserve, ER Funds and Operational Expenses.**

I would ask this committee to consider directing this trusted servant to collect information to assist this committee in creating updated "Operational Expenses:" section of policy that reflects today's business and current spending.

OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES

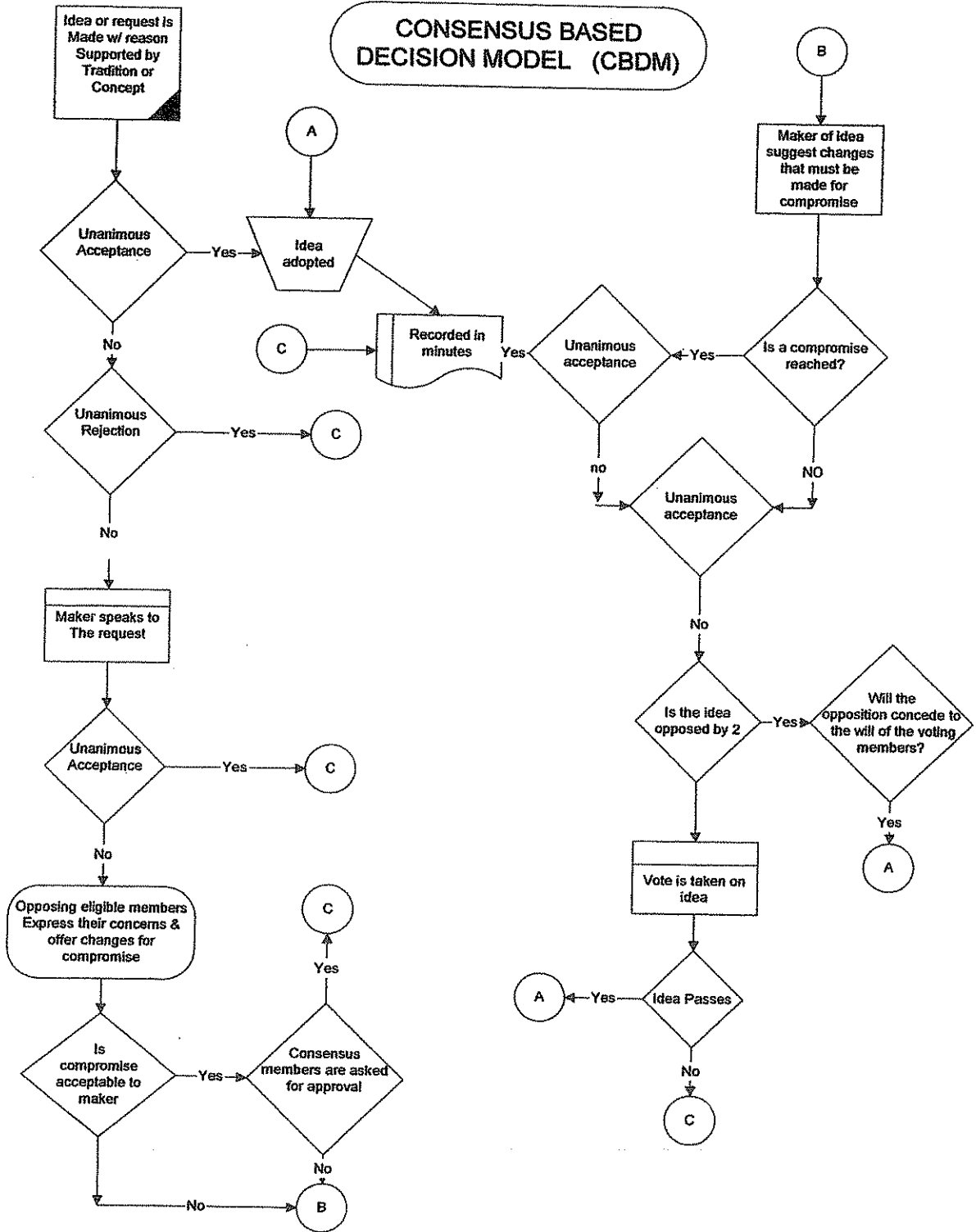
1. This body operates on a consensus based decision-making process (see CBDM model following).
2. Any Idea or Request must be submitted to the secretary in writing before the *Consensus Based Decision Making Process* can begin.
3. As a spiritual body we try to reach all decisions by consensus; we believe that a loving God's will is expressed through our group conscience (2nd tradition). In the event we cannot reach consensus, a decision will be reached using a 2/3 majority vote to reach our decisions.
4. One of the reasons we try to achieve consensus is it insures that we follow our 9th concept, "All elements of our service structure has the responsibility to carefully consider all view points in their decision making process." By carefully discussing and respectfully listening to all points of view we try to make sure this occurs at the committee meetings. The reason all * GSRs are allow to come to a consensus on many decisions is the 7th concept which states, "All GSRs of a service body bear substantial responsibility for that body's decision and should be allowed to fully participate in its decision-making process."
5. All sub-committees will operate with the same process.
6. All committee ideas/request except elections will first be considered using consensus based decisions for the committee's purposes. The process for consensus-based decision-making allows for points of view to be heard and fairly considered within the committee. At this point the chair can recognize WVASC Participants if needed.
7. If at the end of discussion the committee has not reached decision, those dissented from the majority will be given the opportunity to state the reason for their dissent if they choose. If their rationale does not persuade the majority to change their view, the dissenting GSR(s) may be asked if they can support the majority view, even though they themselves do not agree with it. In matters where the dissenters cannot assent to the majority, a decision will be reached using a 2/3 majority vote.
8. When an idea/request is being discussed in new business and time in the WVASC meeting ends, that subject will be brought up in old business at the next WVASC meeting.
9. Any member of the WVASC may submit an idea/request to the floor.
10. GSRs may address request or ideas brought to the floor.
11. Participants may be recognized by the chair.

Debate and Discussion

To avoid confusion and reduce the amount of time spent on WVASC business, the following guidelines have been adopted. They are intended to guide the Chairperson in executing the agenda and are not to be used as a device for the self-interests of individuals. It is the Chairperson's responsibility to guide the WVASC in the debate and discussion of the fellowship's business, upholding Concepts 7 and 9, while following the policies of the WVASC.

1. Debate and discussion are limited to the members of the WVASC, once recognized by the Chairperson. The Chairperson may recognize others at his/her discretion as is prudent by the nature of the business at hand.
2. The difference between discussion and debate are as follows:
 - a. Discussion is that which takes place when there is no idea/request on the floor.
 - b. Debate is that which follows an idea/request and is prior to a consensus.
3. Discussion will occur at times such as in old business, new business, West Valley Area Service Committee Members reports, and committee reports. The Chairperson will at his/her discretion lead the discussion, interpret discussion guidelines, or close the discussion at hand. The guidelines on discussion are as follows:
 - a. Each member may make statements and ask questions on each issue.
 - b. A member may appeal to the Chairperson to continue the discussion after all members have had an opportunity to address the issue under discussion.
 - c. The Chairperson at this time may take a straw poll to determine if continued discussion is necessary.
 - d. The Chairperson may direct that a request or idea is made by the committee at this time.
4. Debate will occur after an idea/request is introduced in new business. To allow the maker of the idea/request and eligible GSRs to fully participate, limits on debate are as follows:
 - a. In debate, each voting member will be given a limit of three minutes to address the idea/request being debated.
 - b. The Chairperson at this time may take a straw poll to determine if continued debate is necessary.
 - c. Questions and/or information pertinent to an idea/request shall be directed to the Chairperson.
 - d. For clarification purposes the chair may recognize eligible members of the WVASC.
 - e. Refer to CBDM Process Model.
 - f. Approved idea/request shall be recorded in the minutes and will become effective as stated in the request/idea.
