Good Afternoon GRS of West Valley Area. It has been a productive month since last Area Meeting. The Adhoc met and is hoping that what we have completed work on would be handled during today's area because budget for vote in October will ~~need to be submitted to the GSR's by September Area so that they can go back to the groups. So what follows is what the adhoc has completed thus far and we will meet again this month to put together recommendations for budget formats, and treasurer's reports.~~

ADHOC committee met on Saturday, May 10th, 2008 7 addicts attended.

Prudent Reserve: Definition:

- WVASCNA Prudent reserve is defined as an amount of money, collected from group donations, and set aside to meet the area's "operational expenses" in the event that group donations decrease.
- Prudent Reserve to be established as two(2) months of average "operating expenses."
- Operating Expenses are determined by projected monthly budget average.
- Projected budgets are to be established by outgoing administrative committee and sub-committee chairs and submitted to the WVASCNA with copies for all active groups and 14 administrative committee members using established area approved budget formats.

The following changes will be made to the Policy and Procedures the words ER funds will be removed from Functions:D.2. page 3. Operational Guidelines: B. Operational Expenses:to reflect changes above.

In addition these changes will establish and add revised Prudent Reserve, Operating Expenses, the approved Treasurers Report and Projected Budgets to Area Policy and Procedures.

Recommendations are to add Bank Statement and Checkbook balance to Treasurers Report, and have Prudent Reserve in place for June and establish fund flow policy and procedure by June as well.

Next meeting is set for June 14th 12:30-1:30, location yet to be determined.



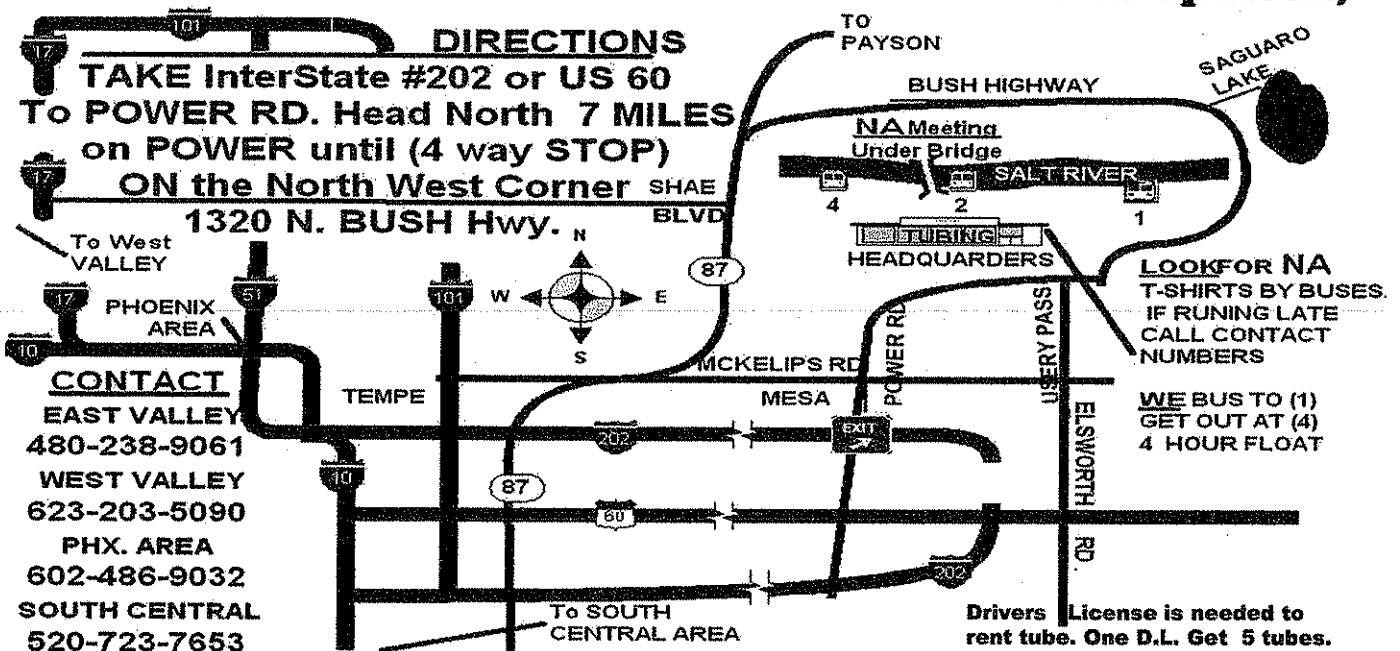

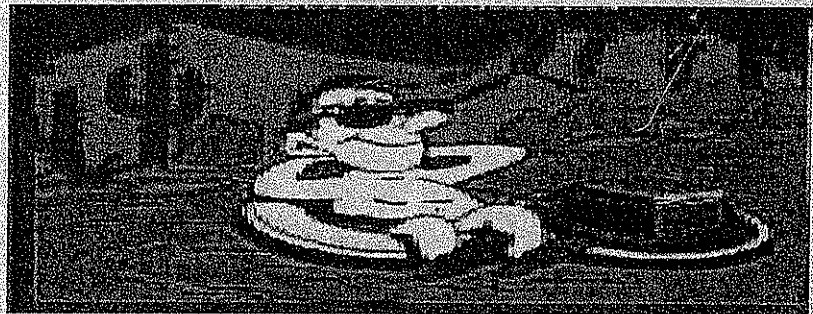
