The Adhoc is continuing to hope we can complete our work so that budgets submitted in September can reflect the new procedures and policies for the vote in October. So what follows is what the Adhoc has completed this month and depending on the outcome of today's area is not planning to meet again.

ADHOC committee meeting scheduled for Saturday, June 14th was cancelled due to P&P Admin.'s illness.

Along with these examples comes some recommendations.

- 1) That ASC utilize the Treasurers Report which contains the ending balance of all Area Business the day prior to area to make any financial decisions, in place of our current practice. Adhoc discussed that in this way we do not have to wait for treasurer to conduct business that involves money, and to be more financial accountable and responsible with Area funds. Example: Area financial business continues after the close of our meeting which includes treasurer paying any bills that are policy to be taken care of, therefore if we are looking at what we collected during business and then look at it to spend we have just practiced what started and the problem this Adhoc was formed to address, utilizing money that may not actually be available. Rather than waiting till the close of the month from prior Area to take a closing balance and work with that. Please see Treasurer Report Summary Sheet.
- 2) That Treasure Report on the Reconciliation of bank statement, including the date it was completed, and report any discrepancies.
- 3) That the Activities Committee monthly treasurers report should closely resemble the Area's to be accountable with their checking account as well.
- 4) That all sub-committees utilize the budget formats to make monthly reports regarding any spending in order to help keep track of the annual spending and proposed budgets.
- 5) There is discussion and input needed to put together what Activities Budget should look like, Adhoc has discussed recommends that Activity submit a proposed Activities and Budgets for those Activities Annually. This to help the Area know what the committee accountable to provide for the area.

I have not scheduled a next meeting this body will let us know by your actions today.
