## Narathon Committee Treasurer's Report June 2008

The bank balance at the end of May 2008 was \$2737.62. Two deposits totaling \$586 were made for wrist band receipts and 2 deposits totaling \$530.00 were made for tee shirts. There was one voided deposit receipt (#4656) originally recorded to be \$333 for wrist band receipts which was later revised to be \$233. This was my mistake and I reported it to Jeff on Monday 6/23 after recounting the receipts handed in at the meeting that night. One check was issued to Dave H. for \$175.00 as payment for Aqua Clips. The balance at June 30, 2008 in our register was \$3,678.62. The balance on the bank statement at June 30, 2008 was \$3,853.62 with the one check still outstanding. That check has now cleared and the current balance on July 12, 2008 at the bank is \$3,678.62 which matches our register.
