#### HELPLINE REPORT 4/14/09 - PHX

The last committee meeting was on April 14, 2009. The operation is running well, with no problems to report. We have good coverage. Shifts that could use another volunteer are Wed midnight to 6am, Tues 6 am to noon, Tues noon to 6pm and Fri 6 pm to midnight. **We are also still looking for a first half rollover. This position is Sun, Mon and Tues 24 hours a day. This position is our back up if our frontline volunteers miss the call. They are also responsible for checking the voicemails and responding or redirecting where appropriate.** We had 3 people to total at the committee meeting including myself, the vice chair and one volunteer from the Phoenix Area. There were no liaisons in attendance. There is no clean time requirement to be on the committee.

We also have 73 volunteers on helpline shifts, 2 on rollover and one on "last house on the block"

We had 812 regular calls and 59 voicemails in March; this is a pretty significant increase and may be due to PSA's starting to be broadcast on the radio

Minimum requirements for a shift are 6 months clean, regular attendance at NA meetings, an NA sponsor, working the steps of NA, and commitment to a 6 hour shift once per week. 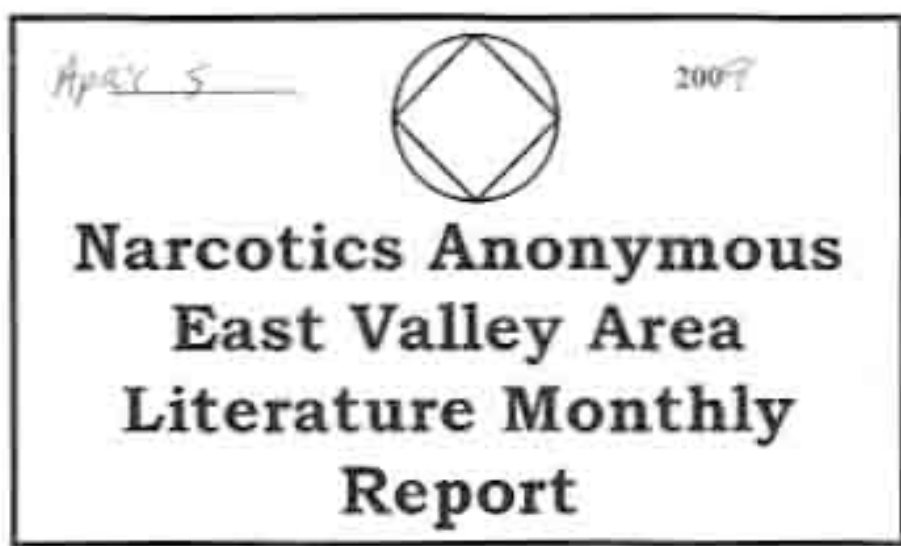

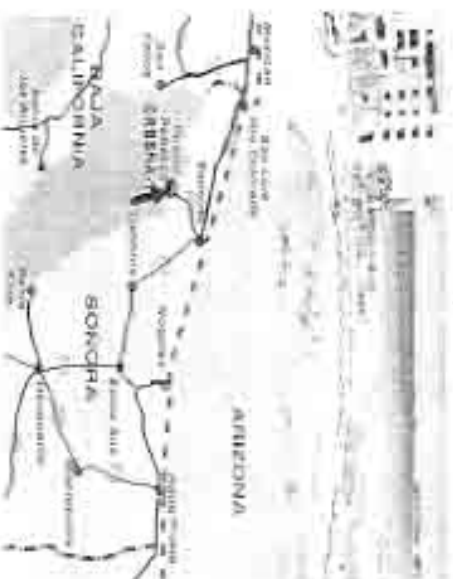
