**Phoenix Area Service Committee
Meeting Minutes for May 2, 2009**

The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Joey, at 12:30 pm with the Serenity Prayer. The Service Prayer was read by Ron, the 12 Concepts read by T.J., and the 12 Traditions read by Jerry. The GSRs approved last month's Minutes. The current month's Agenda was altered to reflect Activities will read its report following the Secretary's Report as the Chair must leave the PASC early. The PASC welcomed new GSRs Brian M. for Space Available and new Alternate GSR Bruce A. for Welcome Home NA at the VA. Space Available was reinstated on the Roll Call.

Roll call was taken by the Secretary. There are 31 active groups in the PASC, with 24 GSRs present, establishing quorum. The Executive Committee and Subcommittees were all present. Announcements at the meeting included upcoming events, with references to flyers and handouts. Reports were presented by the Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, RCM1 and RCM2 Jim B. Copies of all reports are attached. There was one request for open forum.

Old Business was then addressed. A consolidated budget was provided to the GSRs (copy attached following RCM1 report with attachments), which will be brought back to the groups and addressed next PASC. A Statement of Willingness for the Alternate Treasurer position was received from Maria R. A special election was held and Maria was elected Alternate Treasurer.

Reports were presented by all Subcommittees. Copies of Subcommittee reports are attached, except for the Narathon Committee, which has not yet submitted a written report.

The Chair addressed with the GSRs that elections for all PASC positions will be held in July, and we are accepting Statements of Willingness and nominations for all positions at this time. Voting will take place in July, the outgoing and newly elected positions will co-serve in August, with the newly elected individuals assuming their positions in September. Statements of Willingness were received (and are attached) from Maria R. for Alternate Treasurer David D. for Narathon Chair, Jerry A. for Activities Chair, and Chuck H. for RCM1. A blank Service Resume (a/k/a statement of willingness) is attached for your use to submit additional nominees (form at the end of this packet).

New Ideas were presented as follows: (1) By Jim B, RCM 2, to request Region to move the next two Regional GSR Assemblies to be held one in January 2010 and the next one in March 2010 – Adopted; (2) by Beverly P. to remove flashing lights and strobe lights from dances – Adopted (with one opposition); (3) by VandaRay, Crossroads Connection, to Regional Meeting List – out of order; (4) by Skye to add meeting lists to literature order form at no charge and have groups pick them up with literature – Adopted). Copies of all Idea Forms are attached.

The Literature Chair presented his report, followed by the Treasurer's report and disbursement of funds (see attached reports).

The meeting was closed with the Serenity Prayer.

Chair Report
May 2, 2009

Hello to everyone. I would like to thank the entire PASC for allowing me to serve the Phoenix Area.

I would like to first apologize to the PASC. Last month I failed to announce that the PASC elections will be held at the July PASC meeting. The guidelines clearly state that "It will be announced at the April PASC that nominations will be accepted at the beginning of the May PASC." Please excuse this oversight on my part. I am asking that a change to this month's agenda reflect that nominations are now being accepted during New Business.

I have included the "Nominations and Elections" section of the guidelines in my report.

Nominations and Elections of Officers and Committees

A. Nominations

Importance is placed on our recovery being based in Narcotics Anonymous when we do service for Narcotics Anonymous.

1. The PASC elections are held the first week in July of each year.
2. It will be announced at the April PASC that nominations will be accepted at the beginning of the May PASC.
3. Nominations will be closed at the end of the June PASC meeting and all service resumes must be submitted to the PASC prior to the end of the June meeting.
4. Any member of the Phoenix NA fellowship may nominate members for positions on the PASC.
5. Nominees must be present at the July elections.
6. Any member may be nominated for more than one position but may only be elected
7. Prior to the election proceedings at the July PASC, nominees may be asked questions relevant to their possible election.

B. Elections

1. Elections will be conducted by a closed ballot.
2. All election ballots shall be counted by two impartial observers; as assigned by the PASC Chairperson.
3. The secretary shall announce all election results.
4. No member shall hold more than one position at a time.
5. No member shall be eligible to hold more than two consecutive terms in the same position.
6. All PASC officers except RCM's shall be elected to serve for a term of one year beginning at the end of the close of the August PASC. RCM's shall be elected to serve for a term of two years beginning at the close of the August PASC, with one

RCM elected in even-numbered years and the other RCM elected in odd-numbered years.

7. In the event that there are no nominees for a service position at the August elections, special election procedures will begin for that position
8. In the event that a position becomes vacant, Special election procedures will begin for that position.
9. The PASC Chairperson may appoint an individual to fill a vacancy until the Special election for this position is held.

This month I received an email from the Phonline regarding the Activities Subcommittees storage. I spoke with John, the Activities Chairperson, who stated the problem had already been rectified.

A meeting was held with the Phoenix Area Vice-Chair, Treasurer and myself to go over last months request for information on the PASC Income as well as expenditures for the past year. Our Treasurer, Debbie, did a great job in compiling the requested information and it is available for all today. I am sure Debbie will cover this in her report and we will take questions and direction from the GSR's.

HELPLINE REPORT 4/14/09 – PHX2

The last committee meeting was on April 14, 2009. The operation is running well, with no problems to report. We have good coverage. Shifts that could use another volunteer are Wed and Thurs midnight to 6am, Tues and Thurs (2 volunteers needed) 6 am to noon, and Wed noon to 6 pm. **We have found not one but two volunteers for the rollover!!!** We had 7 people total at the committee meeting including myself, the vice chair and 3 volunteers from the Phoenix Area and 2 from the East Valley.
