

This does not give them the opportunity to look at projects in the works or plan for the upcoming year. It also happens so soon after the convention that it almost guarantees that too much of the income gained from the convention is sent on to world before proper financial planning can be done.

Regional Delegate; Will be attending the Western States Zonal Forum in July.

Regional Delegate Alternate; Will be providing a workshop on Building strong Home Groups for The Peaks Area on 6/7/9. Ken is also available to do workshops on Our freedom Our responsibility. He also submitted Greg W.s Human Resources Resume for Regional endorsement so that The World Board knows that Greg has our support in his efforts to be elected to the World Board of Directors.

Board of Directors Liaison; Elected were: Ed G. Executive Officer, Dennis Board Member, Rick Policy, Mike C. Regional Liaison. Four positions remain open on the B.O.D. Chief Executive Officer, Insurance Liaison, and two regular board seats. We have submitted our financials to Region and expect our Regional audit by August.

Hospital and Institutions; Sponsorship behind the walls is off to a good start. All requests for literature have been filled. Looking for a replacement for ARSCH&I Chairperson 5 year clean-time requirement. Currently not spending \$200.00 per month of our available budget.

Public Relations; Can not run for or serve another term, good luck in finding someone to serve. We have three events upcoming August back to school kickoff. The booth is available the cost is between \$100.00 and \$350.00 we are not getting enough of the necessary volunteers from local Areas. Art of Recovery 9/19/09 at Phoenix Civic Plaza. Need to set up badges for the event. Cost is \$250.00 for the booth and \$500.00 for the Literature.

Webservant; Our budget is \$500.00 annually Clean-time requirement of 5 years to chair.

CAAN; Made donations to the ARSC for the past two Regional meetings even though they have not been able to attend.

East Valley; Attendance at the GSR Forums has been great and is improving even more. We will be holding dances on 6/19/09 and 7/17/09. Our contribution to ARSC is \$1233.00.
