Ad hoc newsletter committee

7/18/09

Hello Family!

This month the committee has been hard at work. We e-mailed more than twenty NA newsletters across the country to request help to develop guidelines for creating a newsletter committee, and we've received six responses.

Of those who responded, clean time requirements to chair varied from one to three years. Our committee suggests two years. This is for two reasons. The most obvious is that it is required by WVASC guidelines. The second is because of the type of newsletter we're trying to produce. All the responses we received were from newsletters that include potentially controversial material (commentary, Q & A, clean dates, etc). Our publication, on the other hand, will be limited to service opportunities, meeting changes, and activities. We don't believe that there is the need for an editor with a huge amount of clean time to produce what is basically an informational bulletin. If the Area decides that those types of articles might be useful in the future, we would certainly want to change our guidelines.

In the meantime, we have developed guidelines that borrow heavily from the other WVASC sub-committee guidelines, especially the Activities and Outreach sub-committees. One thing that I'm sure everyone will notice is that we changed the number of printed copies from thirty (30) to forty (40). When we did the first count, we didn't include vacant positions or all of the homegroups. This will increase the printing cost from approximately eleven dollars (\$11) to approximately fifteen dollars (\$15) per month. I apologize for the confusion. However, it's been pointed out that the format of the newsletter will allow us to get the word out about at least a dozen activities and general announcements in a four page spread. In my experience as a GSR, I've often found that there aren't enough copies of fliers to supply all of my homegroup. It'd be nice to have a single source that listed all of the activities in the Valley.

There's another change from our initial presentation. We originally planned to have the Secretary of the administrative board print copies to bring to Area. However, we received input at the GSR assembly and were encouraged to add the position of treasurer to the newsletter committee to streamline the process and to keep from adding work to the secretary's role. Although none of the newsletters we contacted had guidelines for their treasurer, we suggest that the treasurer have two years clean time because they will be dealing with such a small amount of money.

I must say that I'm proud of the work the committee has done and hope that it shows. I look forward to your questions and comments.

SAMPLE GUIDELINES

Primary Purpose

The Newsletter Subcommittee's primary purpose is to carry the message of Narcotics Anonymous and to provide information to the West Valley to foster unity and encourage involvement in NA events and service.

Functions

- A. To present a newsletter to the WVASC every month.
- B. To supply information about meeting changes, service opportunities, and NA events in a clear, easy-to-read format.
- C. To provide one copy for each GSR, board member, and sub-committee chair at each monthly WVASC meeting.
- D. To announce any corrections prior to the end of the monthly WVASC meeting.
- E. To limit printing expenses by providing the newsletter by e-mail to any interested NA member on the mailing list.
- F. To keep clear and accurate financial records of printing expenses.

Committee members

The committee members will consist of a chairperson, vice-chairperson, editor, information coordinator, secretary, and treasurer, all of whom, other than the chairperson are elected by the Newsletter sub-committee. In keeping with Tradition Five, all NA members are encouraged to participate in Newsletter sub-committee meetings.

Chairperson

Requirements:

- A. Two years clean time
- B. Knowledge and experience of WVASC
- C. Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of NA.

Duties:

- A. Prepares an agenda and presides over all Newsletter sub-committee meetings.
- B. Prepares progress and financial reports and attends the monthly WVASC meetings as the voice of the newsletter committee.
- C. Co-ordinates and is responsible for all work done by the Newsletter sub-committee.
- D. Submits a projected annual expense budget to the Area Treasurer.

Vice-chairperson

Requirements:

- A. Two years clean time
- B. Knowledge and experience at WVASC
- C. Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of NA

Duties

- A. Attends all Newsletter sub-committee meetings.
- B. Works with the chairperson to ensure the smooth running of the sub-committee and performs the duties of the chairperson in case of absence.
- C. Will step in to fill the role of the chairperson, editor, information coordinator, secretary, or treasurer in their absence.

Editor

Requirements:

- A. Two years clean time
- B. Knowledge and experience at WVASC
- C. Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of NA
- D. Unrestricted access to a computer.

Duties:

1. Attends all Newsletter sub-committee meetings
2. Works closely with the Information Coordinator to develop content for the newsletter.
3. Develops and produces the format of the newsletter.
4. Delivers a printable edition to the treasurer a week prior to the monthly WVASC meeting.

Information Coordinator

Requirements:

- A. Two years clean time
- B. Knowledge and experience at WVASC
- C. Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of NA

Duties:

1. Attends all Newsletter sub-committee meetings.
2. Contacts each sub-committee chair to determine the need for service positions and clean time requirements, as well as the date, time, and location of the next sub-committee meeting.
3. Obtains information about up-coming events.
4. Works closely with the Editor to provide information two weeks prior to the monthly WVASC meeting.

Secretary

Requirements:

- A. One year clean time
- B. Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of NA

Duties:

- A. Attends all Newsletter sub-committee meetings.
- B. Records the minutes of every Newsletter sub-committee meeting and maintains the archives.
- C. Distributes copies of the minutes to each sub-committee member prior to the next meeting.
- D. E-mails the newsletter to everyone on the mailing list.

Treasurer

Requirements:

- A. Two years clean time
- B. Working knowledge of the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions of NA
- C. Completed "Statement of Understanding and Financial Responsibility"

Duties:

- A. Attends all Newsletter sub-committee meetings.
- B. Prints (40) copies of the newsletter prior to the monthly WVASC meeting.
- C. Maintains an accurate record of the printing expenses, and submits the receipts to the chairperson prior to the monthly WVASC meeting.

Proofreaders

Requirement:

- A. Three months clean time

Duties

- A. Meets with the editor two weeks prior to the monthly WVASC meeting to proofread each edition.

OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES

A. Participants

- 1. Must be members of NA.

B. Terms of office

- 1. At the first Newsletter meeting following the WVASC election each year, the committee will elect all officers who will assume their duties immediately.
- 2. All retired officers will serve as an advisory committee to assist newly elected officers for a period of two months.
- 3. No elected officer may hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms. Short-term replacements (defined as the filling of any elected position mid-term) are not counted as term.

C. Voting procedures

- 1. The Newsletter sub-committee will hold regular monthly meetings in a centrally-located place at a pre-set date and time. Special meetings may be called by a majority vote or by the chairperson or vice-chairperson upon request.
- 2. Each member of the Newsletter sub-committee will have one vote, and each officer can vote, except the chairperson, who votes only in the case of a tie.
- 3. Any member not present for two consecutive meetings will not be able to vote and any new member may vote at their second consecutive meeting.

D. Fiscal responsibility

- 1. At the monthly sub-committee meeting, the treasurer will make a written report and submit it to the chairperson.
- 2. The chairperson will then submit a check request to the WVASC treasurer to pay for the following month's printing expense.
- 3. The chairperson will return the completed check to the treasurer who will then make copies prior to the WVASC meeting the following month.

HELPLINE REPORT 7/14/09

The last committee meeting was on July 14, 2009. The operation is running well, with no problems to report. We have good coverage. Shifts that could use another volunteer are Wed 12 am to 6 am, Tues and Thurs 6 am to noon. We had 3 people total at the committee meeting including myself, the vice chair and 1 volunteers from the Phoenix Area. There were no liaisons in attendance; no attendees from East or West Valley areas. There is no clean time requirement to be on the committee.

The Helpline Chair position remains open

PI had PSA's starting to air in June; we did not see a significant increase in calls

We will be doing a TSLD for the Phoenix area on July 18th at Crossroads at 1845 E Ocotillo from 1 to 6 pm; food will be provided and we will play service recovery jeopardy.

We have 71 volunteers on the primary helpline shifts, 4 on Spanish, 4 on rollover and one on "last house on the block" for a total of 80 volunteers. We also have around 90 to 100 volunteers on our 12 step list.

We had 700 regular calls and 50 voicemails in June

Minimum requirements for a shift are 6 months clean, regular attendance at NA meetings, an NA sponsor, working the steps of NA, and commitment to a 6 hour shift once per week.
