Attached is the proposed Board of Directors Budget request the year 2010. The total requested for the year is \$6,400.00. Changes from the previous years request include an increase in member travel to accommodate Site Location expenses and increased mileage reimbursements for out of town board members.

Decreases in this request include Storage and Insurance, the amounts for Professional Services and Operating expense remain the same. I believe this budget can pay for some one to take minutes of our board meetings as has been previously approved by the BOD.

The 2008 tax return was completed and sent timely to the IRS and Arizona Department of Revenue. Accountant fees for tax return preparation was \$716.25. Our current balance in the BOD checking is \$3,971.25 with projected expenditures of \$1,850.00 by years end.

The projected spending includes Storage renewal, Directors insurance coverage's and member travel.

Total balance as of today in all ARSC, Inc. bank accounts is \$38,750.15; balances in separate accounts are as follows:

A letter was sent to Tucson Medical Center in response to a request from the Southeastern Area NA to provide non profit status of ARSC, Inc. for continued preferential treatment of meeting space at that facility. I have the copy of that letter for your review.
