Our Area will be conducting elections for trusted at our December meeting. At this time, it appears that we will be able to fill all of our positions. The problem, as usual, is that most of these positions will be filled with the same core group of recovering addicts - the same people wearing different hats. We are having only limited success getting new people involved in our Area service structure beyond the GSR level.

The Yavapai Area held a Breakfast/ Speaker Meeting in Prescott on November 1, 2009. Addicts enjoyed a time of fun and fellowship in an atmosphere of recovery. We would like to thank Mo for sharing her experience, strength, and hope with us. We are making preliminary plans for our Unity Day campout next September and have reserved a location for that event.

The local treatment center in our Area is changing to a new (non 12-step) treatment program due to new federal guidelines. At the present time, we do not know how these changes will affect our ability to carry NA panel meetings into these types of facilities. Meanwhile, we continue to carry the message to addicts who cannot attend NA meetings regularly. Our Area sent six Basic Texts into the Yavapai County jail in Camp Verde this month.

Our local groups will be combining their joint resources to buy NA literature (informational pamphlets) for their meetings. Several meetings are often conducted at the same location.

We have a \$202.80 donation for Area.

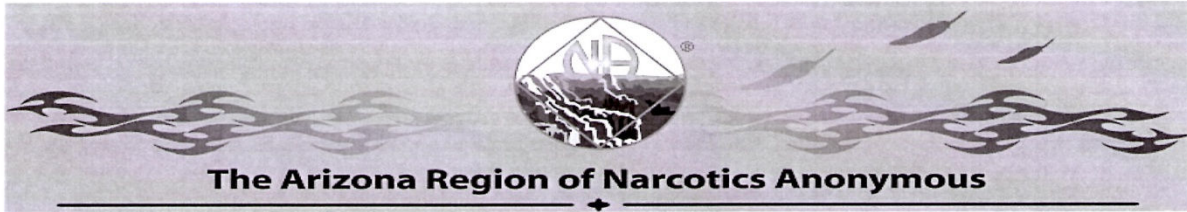

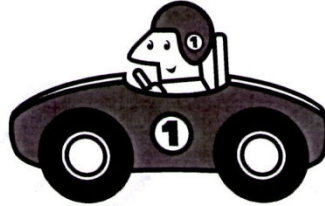
