Balance in all ARSC, Inc. bank accounts as of 01/17/2010 is \$25,836.04. This balance is not reconciled from 12/31/2009 to present as additional transactions in the Regional and ARCNAXXIV accounts have not been reported. Attached is a copy of the Chase bank account summary as of 01/16/2010.

The Directors & Officers insurance policy was paid at a cost of \$915.00. I have the renewed policy to forward to the Insurance Liaison.

One half of the BOD 2010 budget will be transferred today from the Regional checking in the amount of \$2,198.68 with the remaining balance transfer in March.

All ARSC, Inc. bank accounts and transactions for calendar year 2009 have been reconciled to year end and transactions recorded. Attached is a 2009 Profit and Loss Statement. I will send tax information to the CPA by the end of this month. Thanks to both the Region and ARCNA treasurers for timely reports.

New Year's Narathon deposited \$658.00 total credit card transactions into the Paymentech account. The bankcard fee for these deposits totaled \$32.29; I transferred the balance of \$625.71 to Regional checking account as previously agreed to by Regional and Narathon treasurers. The bankcard fee was approximately 4.9% of deposits.

ARCNA Vice Treasurer was added as cosigner to the ARCNA account as approved at our last BOD meeting.

Southeastern Area Public Information committee chair requested a letter sent to Sun Tran in Tucson to allow Posters for NA to be displayed in their buses. I received an email (copy attached) from the Insurance Liaison Mike S.

I initially agreed to provide a letter, however, after talking to three different people to find out who was actually requesting this letter and speaking to the Region and BOD CEOs, I felt this matter should be addressed at this BOD meeting and some procedures for dealing with like matters be addressed.

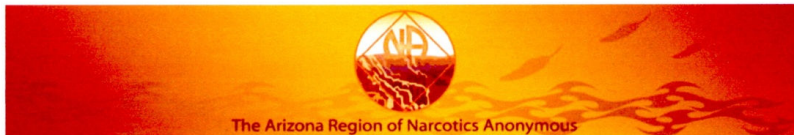

Greetings to all from the Phoenix Area!!

The holiday season has come and gone. All three of our Narathon events were successful and well attended; a safe place to be during the holidays.

I attended the CAR Workshop / Regional Assembly; I counted approximately 20 participants from the Phoenix Area, including 16 or 17 GSRs. The event went smoothly and was very informative. Thanks to Vince and Ken for facilitating.

At our area, the chair had a few clarifications:

- Quorum consists of more than 50 % of voting members, not 2/3 as we had previously used
- Open Forum is for members other than participants at the Area level
