Motion 9: Revise the **Just For Today**. Straw poll third and third and third.

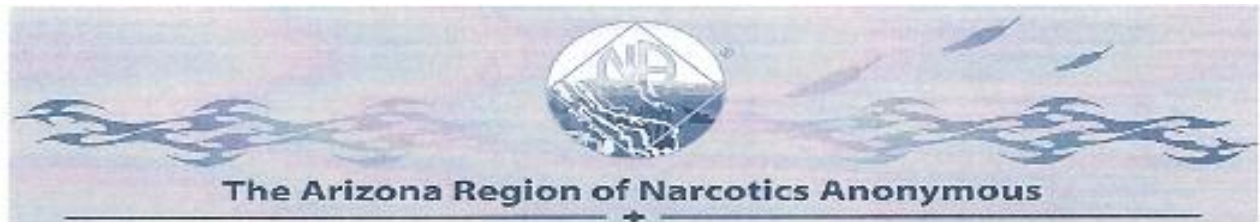
Motion 10: Post conference approval track at the same time as sent out to conference participants. Straw poll pass.

East Valley Public Relations Subcommittee Report

### **My Recovery Journey Companions,**

Cheryl I. agreed to be Secretary for the committee and was approved by unanimous proclamation.

The Beacon was mailed at the end of December, 2009 and we made assignments for the next issue which will go out at the end of March. Included with the Beacon was a flyer with information about the Newcomer Workshop.

We met the last Tuesday of December at Annia's house to practice our presentation of the Newcomer Workshop to be held at Recovery and Beyond at 2pm January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2009. We believe we are ready and hope to have a good turnout.

We are planning on having another flyer distribution day and tentatively scheduled it for Saturday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010. We are checking to see if the date is clear and will have a flyer next month with more information.

We want to thank the homegroups for your group conscience concerning the New Times ad funding. We would like to encourage you to notice what community or neighborhood newspapers are in the area where your homegroup meets. Often these papers will print meeting times and locations for community events such as your Narcotics Anonymous meeting for free if they occur within their geographic boundaries. Please contact me if you would like more information about and/or help with placing these local ads.

Cheryl I. contacted the Mesa, Tempe and Chandler Public libraries about placing the Spanish Basic Text and It Works: How and Why books. A cover letter addressed to the contact person at each library with English text on one side and Spanish text on the opposite side accompanies each group of books being placed at these libraries. We are ready to order more Spanish texts to place in libraries.

I was approached by the Area Chairperson and asked if I could reduce the yearly budget we currently have been approved for. I reviewed the amounts budgeted and am now tracking the amounts the committee is spending on each line item in the budget. I wasn't doing that before. It appears the Beacon budget may actually be over allotted about \$90 and I am unsure how much it will actually cost to make TV Public Service Announcements. I haven't done it in 15 years and although the TV stations have recently told me they want the PSAs on tape, when pressed they may relent and agree to accept an electronic format which is cheaper to deliver to them. I will try.

I will include with my report a running tally of each budgeted line item in order to show financial accountability for this subcommittee to the homegroups.

Hey there,

We had 534 calls in December, of which 32 went to voice-mail. It's too early in the month for the bills to be posted from Qwest and Accessline, but it should be close to the usual \$150 split three ways. I think we've worked out billing for WVA going forward, sending soft copy to their secretary as a stop gap since they don't have a liaison at this point. I'll need to work with our treasurer to make sure we have an accurate billing picture to communicate to them this month. Still have some slots to fill, and we don't yet have a valley-wide consensus on the 3-hour shift change. West Valley didn't have quorum last month, so they weren't able to conduct business. We did tell them about NA Bedside last month, and I think Paul will address this in his Outreach report. It's an idea from East Valley that was in last month's Helpline report about volunteers taking meetings to addicts that are in the hospital and can't make it to a regular meeting – similar to the 12-step list. There's also more info about NA Bedside in our meeting minutes posted to <http://docs.google.com> – ask Angela if you'd like access to them.

This month we're meeting at the Next Coffee Company, 59<sup>th</sup> Ave and Utopia on Tuesday, January 12<sup>th</sup> at 7PM.
