This new yard previously housed male inmates who all Had less than a year to the gate and we were taking a meeting to them, When the men were moved out and the women moved in we were unable to continue the meeting due to a lack of female volunteers and we felt it was inappropriate for the male to take a meeting on to a female yard. We are excited about starting a new meeting at this location because it is a minimum security yard with inmates who are hungry for something to help them upon their release.

Treatment center

We are still in need of volunteers to co chair at Aurora this being our primary need in the treatment area now.

Men's and Women's Jails

We are fully staffed up at the womens jail but need an interested female for womens federal prison. Durango juvenile is still in need of a meeting and the only thing holding us back are interested volunteers. We had 5 members who were interested and given the information to get clearance but had little follow through. Lewis prison is also still open.

Literature

We received our literature late last month due to the holidays and expect a high volume of orders this month.

We distributed \$25.90 last month and will be placing a lit order of \$ 338.50 this month.
