Hello All,

Since I've been here last, I have conducted three literature workshops on the Living Clean: The Journey Continues project.

The first one was in Peaks Area at the end of November. We had two tables thirteen participants in all. Both tables had participants from Peaks with more than 20 years clean and each table had a participant with a year or less. We worked on chapter 6.

The second workshop was in Verde Valley Area on February 13th. We had four tables each with participants with more than 20 years clean and each table had participants with a year or less. We worked on chapter 7. We had several members whom had participated in at least one of our other Living Clean: The Journey Continues workshops. We had seven participants per table.

The third workshop on the Living Clean: The Journey Continues Book at the Regional Assembly went very well. We had attendance by quite a few 20 plus year members from all over the Region at least one per table. The participants were given the opportunity to participate directly with writing on this book. Currently, there is room for a maximum of 10 characters for the codes. We propose that one way we can accomplish both legibility and continuity is by standardizing our format codes

YOUR ASSISTANCE NEEDED: We believe that the home group is the best judge of which code(s) accurately identifies their format. That being stated, please present the following Meeting Add/Change Sheet to your GSR's and ask if they would review this legend, make any changes that apply and return the info to the DC via the usual method agreed upon by your ASC's.

We will need to translate – to the best of our ability – meeting formats for home groups who do not submit an update.

Bear in mind that we are also attempting to recover space on the printed directory using 4 or less characters per format and it is entirely possible that our legend needs editing as well.
