Hello all! Not much to add to Ed's report.

The only additional topic discussed was WSLD. The motion to approve sending representatives from EVANA did not contain any direction from the GSR's about what they wanted the Guidelines to say about WSLD, if anything. The language from the 2007 Guidelines is below:

V. Participation

C. Operating Guidelines

19. Sets aside \$1,200.00 in one lump sum for the purpose of sending the H&I and PI representatives to the Western Service Learning Day (WSLD). This becomes part of the prudent reserve.

Under the heading of Treasurer:
Maintains \$1,200.00 in prudent reserve for WSLD.

It is important to note that we, as a committee, are not advocating for inclusion of any particular language. Our job is merely to bring to your attention discrepancies and sections of the Guidelines that may be confusing and need clarification.
