During this meeting, we discussed the direction of Public Information with input from the H&I Chair, and the former P I Chair. The Chairs assignment for the next meeting was to make contact with The East Valley PI Chair, the Phoenix Metro P I Chair, and the Regional PR chair. PREFACE: As agreed upon by the RCM's early in the creation of the Directory Committee (DC) we need to have 1 common legend that we *all* can use, one that is also compatible with World's for our meeting update process (refer to DC guidelines). Updates are essential to accurately reflect the meetings in our Region which are listed on the World website, as well as our own, and we now have the technology that will facilitate that.

Creating space on the printed directory is part of the ongoing mission of producing a directory that contains as much accurate information as possible that is also legible. Currently, there is room for a maximum of 10 characters for the codes. We propose that one way we can accomplish both "readability" and standardizing our format codes is to get each home group's input.

YOUR ASSISTANCE NEEDED: We believe that the home group is the best judge of which code(s) accurately identifies their format. That being stated, please present the following Meeting Add//Change Sheet to your GSR's and ask if they would review and compare their format codes with this legend and return the changes to the DC via the usual method agreed upon by your ASC's. We will need to translate -- to the best of our ability -- meeting formats for home groups who do not return an update.

Bear in mind that we are also attempting to recover space on the printed directory using 1 or 2 characters per format and it is entirely possible that our legend needs editing as well. If you, your webmaster, your GSR's or any other members have suggestions for the legend, please forward them to the DC at MeetingList@Arizona-Na.org.

There were 712 calls in the month of March, of which 35 were voicemails. The Accessline bill was \$92.59 and the Qwest bill was \$58.55 for a total of \$151.14 or \$50.38 per area. Our meeting minutes are posted on Google Docs, as is this report, our training info and the 12-step list, and if you'd like access, just let us know so we can add you. We still have a lot of action items open that don't require a phone-shift commitment, so there are ways to be of service to your helpline even if your schedule is a problem. The 12-step list is posted, but always needs to have members verified. There's testing to be done, and we'd like to start using a database to keep all the bits and pieces under control.

We currently have shift vacancies on Friday morning, Friday evening, and on Saturday from midnight to 6AM. We're also trying to load up the daytime shifts early in the week with extra volunteers since call volume seems to be high and our roll-over folks (Angela and me) have jobs that make it tough to answer the phone at will. Roll-over commitments are now just 24 hours, so if you know someone or are someone that might be interested, let us know.

Other Issues that Will Be Discussed at WSC 2010

Those of you who read and discuss the CAR every two years will remember that the past several CARs have contained discussion questions, usually about the Issue Discussion Topics. This year, we don't have any particular questions to ask about the IDTs, but we are trying something new here on this summary page in briefly mentioning some of the other issues that we know will be discussed at the conference. We encourage you to read the related essays in this CAR.

Service System (page 8)

At WSC 2010, we will be discussing options for improved service delivery throughout all components of our service system: structure, process, people, and resources. We want to forward these discussions through the 2010-2012 cycle. We encourage everyone to read the essay on page 8 to gain all of the background information and share your ideas with your delegate so that we can have fruitful discussions at the conference and beyond.

NAWS Resources (page 17)

We have all been affected by the economic downturn, some of us more directly than others. In this CAR we discuss NAWS resources, and the *Annual Report* provides more detailed information. We are continuing to seek ways to cut costs at world services while reducing the impact on service delivery as much as possible. One of the items we will discuss with conference participants is *The NA Way Magazine*. We understand there is some benefit from this magazine to our members and to NAWS, yet we are aware of the waste that comes from automatic distribution of paper copies to all registered NA groups. We would like to discuss possible solutions with conference participants and to try changes in distribution before making any changes to policy. Please read the essay on page 17 and help your delegate come ready to discuss our NA Way distribution practices.

Literature Development (page 28)

Several of the regional motions in this CAR focus on some aspect of the literature development process. We hope to have a more holistic discussion at the conference about the literature development process, including how to more effectively involve interested members. How realistic is our current review and input process with our worldwide membership, and does this process positively affect our literature? Does a lengthy approval process make sense when approval is simply a "yes" or "no" for a completed work? What literature processes would serve us best today and in the future? We look forward to discussing all of these issues at the conference. Please read the essay on page 28 and share your thoughts with your delegate.
