The next Newcomer Workshop will be held Sunday, May 16th, at Recovery and Beyond at 2pm. Attendance was low at the last workshop and we discussed how we might improve it.

Robert B. reported the literature racks at TASC and OCW(Our Common Welfare) are doing well. He also committed to investigating how the literature racks at EVAC are being stocked and will report next month.

The World Service Office has finally started posting Public Service Announcements which various areas and regions around world have made. There are currently 3 English video PSAs and 1 Spanish video PSA posted on the Locally Developed Resources page. We viewed the English versions in addition to the PSAs the WSO developed in the 1980s and the committee selected one from Rose City Area in Texas to air on Valley TV stations. By networking I have found someone in the industry with the technical expertise to dub in our local contact information. They charge \$55 an hour and said their rate is negotiable. As soon as this is accomplished we will begin contacting the TV stations to get it on the air.

By the time you read this we will have had our flyer posting event on Saturday, May 8th. I hope you were there. Cheryl submitted her report on the library project and the Beacon is on track to be mailed out at the end of next month.

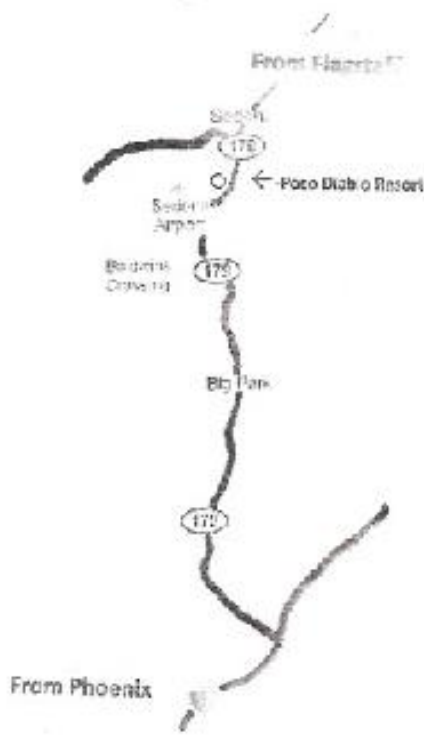

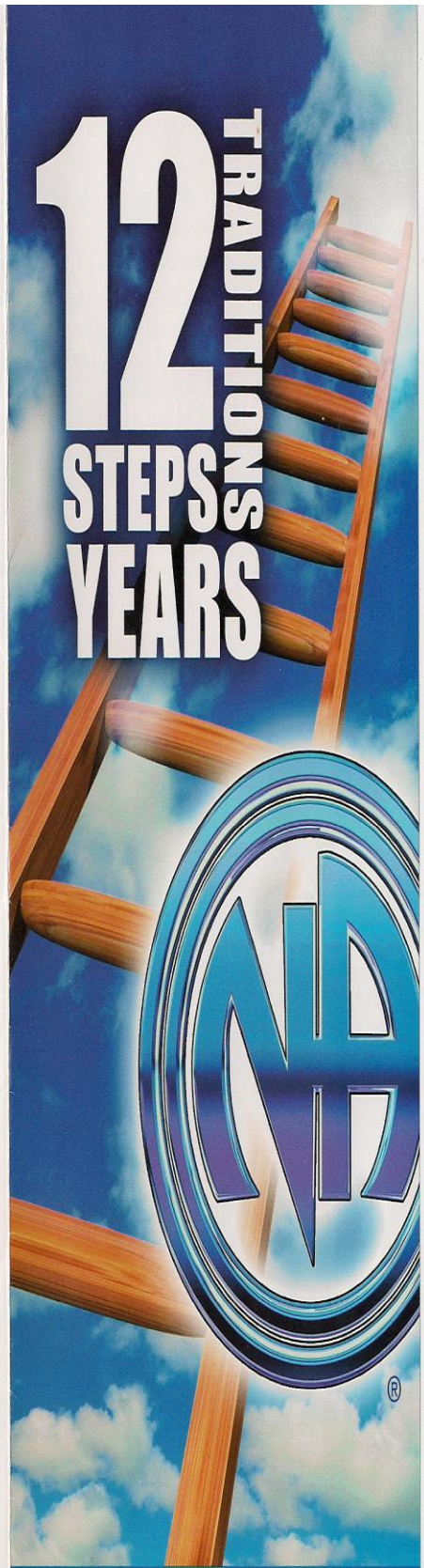

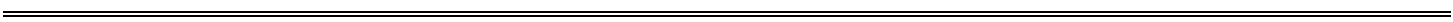
