**motion 4** - To approve the revisions to In Times of Illness **PASSED**

**Regional Motion Do not hit the floor in the order of the CAR.**

**motion 6** - To add purple key tags for multiple decades of clean time to the NAWS inventory **DID NOT PASS**

**Motion 5** - Direct NAWS to produce and add to inventory a purple decades clean and granite decade clean key tag in English only. **DID NOT PASS**

**motion 8** - The World Board is directed to develop a project plan for presentation to WSC 2012 for a Traditions Working Guide. **PASSED.**

**motion 12** - To add language to the end of the Approval Process for Recovery Material section of GWSNA, page 36, that says, "No more than two informational pamphlets or one booklet or one book-length piece will be out for Fellowship review and input at the same time." **DID NOT PASS**

**motion 10** - The World Board will post on the NAWS Website the motions that pertain to the Conference Approval Track at the same time the Conference Approval Track is sent out to Conference Participants. Standing vote 42 yes 64 against 2 abstain 3 present **DID NOT PASS**

**motion 13** - To add language to the end of the Approval Process for Recovery Material section of GWSNA, page 36, that says, "Review and Input periods will be at least six months for informational pamphlets and booklets and at least one year for book-length pieces of literature." **DID NOT PASS**

**motion 11** - The World Board will post on [na.org](http://na.org) all recovery literature workgroup meeting records in English within 30 days of any workgroup meeting. The World Board will also link these postings to any project resources: such as the projects discussion board, or similar resource. This post will include the project's timeline and a schedule of workgroup meetings. The WB will also post their 2010 CAR meeting schedule & have the discretion to post an overview of the literature development process or any other additional information. **DID NOT PASS**

**motion 7** - To add a Spanish (Castilian) Line Numbered Large Print Basic Text, in the current edition, to NAWS inventory. **DID NOT PASS**

**motion 14** - To require a 180-day review and input period for Fellowship Approved, Conference Approved, or World Board Approved material. **DID NOT PASS**

## **Public Information Subcommittee Report - April 1, 2010**

We had a very poor turn out at our PI meeting last month, 3 committee members and 2 guests. Lamont, the West Valley PI Chair and Bee, the West Valley PI secretary joined us. They shared their ideas and activities with us, and we discussed how we may be able to work together in the future. They have some great ideas and have implemented some exciting campaigns to spread the NA message. We look forward to continuing to collaborate with them.

Because of our poor attendance at the last two PI meetings, we have shifted our focus to attracting and recruiting new PI committee members. If you or anyone you know may be interested in serving on the PI committee please let me know. We need help.

Further, we do not have anyone who has submitted a letter of willingness to serve as the PI chair next year. Again, please consider taking on this service commitment, and if you are willing to serve let me know. I cannot do it again next year, but I am willing to remain on the committee. If no one steps up, we will be without a chair, hence – no committee. That would be very bad.

Last month I attended TSLD along with Jeff H, the regional PI chair, and Ruth. It was a pathetic turn out and very disappointing. Jeff & I ran through the PI Powerpoint presentation. We had hoped to recruit some new PI committee members there, but that did not happen.

We will be printing a couple hundred more posters in varying sizes to distribute to locations such as TASC, outpatient treatment centers, doctor's offices, hospital ER's, pain management clinics, urgent cares, laundromats, court buildings, jails, convenience stores, and other locations where addicts tend to go. We will use the slogan, –"Drug Problem? We can help" with the same colors and general lay out of the last poster.

One of our PI members has joined the Sunnyslope Taskforce on Prevention (of Substance Abuse), and through this contact the Phoenix Police Department has expressed interest in meeting with the PI committee to get better acquainted with NA. We may be attending Blockwatch meetings to talk about NA and perhaps working with the PD to coordinate 12 step calls. Much more to be revealed on this, but we are excited about it.
