Greetings family,

Meeting lists, as you will note, they have been printed a bit randomly. Bethany is checking with them to see if they will give us a discount on the next printing.

Next meeting list issue, any meetings that have not updated their formats will have them updated by the appointed person for the meeting lists and you may or may not be disappointed with the results. The one thing that I really want not have incorrect in the meeting list is whether or not your meeting is closed. Is there anyone

here that represents a closed meeting?

On to the report May's regional meeting.

The agenda was modified so that ARCNA elections could be held. The results are as follows: Chair –Mike M.; Vice Chair-Jim G; Treasurer – Heidi and Angie L. was appointed Vice Treasurer. Her resume will be in the regional minutes and she will be voted in or not in July.

Chair and Vice Chair had no written reports. The Chair did ask that groups not represented at Region have their donations acknowledged. This actually turned out to be an East Valley home group, therefore it was determined that they have representation as Region and I honestly do not know how that will be addressed in the future.

RD and RDA handed out a disc from the WSC 2010 which is full of information from the conference. Attached to my report is the Summary of Decisions concerning the motions that we voted on at the CAR workshops. There is more information on this disc than I have yet to consume, if anyone would like a copy please let me know and I will bring them to the next area meeting or you can get them before your next home group meeting.

One of the changes is that if you want to continue receiving “paper” mailings of NAWS publications, you must log on to the web site and opt in. As our fellowship is funded mostly on literature sales and donations are down the cost to continue mailing items that are available in electronic format is extremely prohibitive.

Another issue that will be addressed by NAWS this cycle is internet usage, ie facebook, twitter etc. For those of you that use it, please remember that anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all of our traditions and plastering our faces on facebook is probably a violation of our traditions, especially if you haven't obtained the permission of the people you are showing or worse yet, have been asked not to take pictures and are doing it anyway.

Don't know the traditions? Not to worry, One of the project plans for 2012 will be the Traditions Working Guide. In the meantime you can work with one of the rogue guides that are out or perhaps your sponsor may be of help to you.

On the disc is also a draft of a fellowship survey for input on new literature and revision of old literature. More will be revealed on that particular form.

Treasurer-balance at the end of the meeting was \$4,415.57 which is above prudent reserve by \$415.57. I have not received an amended report.

H & I has had much contact from DOC recently. Sponsorship behind the walls is taking off.

Literature Review – Jim is anxious to start work on the Traditions Working Guide which may be premature.

We got the T-shirts printed for the Blue fest by a different company called new city promotions. So, the Blues Fest currently has shirts for sell. On the first order we saved \$144.48 versus using rainbow graphics and over the next two orders we will save \$100-\$130 per order based on the order. We also sold 30 of last year's t-shirts at \$ 5 a piece with a total of \$150 brought in. We sold 24 of this year's t-shirts at \$15 each with a total of \$360 brought in at the ARCNA convention.

Also the application for the Sister Cities Park at Kiwanis Park in Tempe has been turn in with the \$ 35 check for the application fee.

Next, I would like to mention some of the things that we are planning for this years Blues fest , we are planning to have comedians at the event doing stand up bits between the bands, also we are wanting to have meetings going on during the event, except during the main speaker event. We are looking to have some things for people to do at the event, like pie in the face, bean bags toss to win prizes and hopefully some other stuff to make this event more exciting.

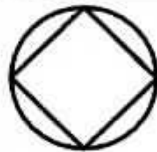

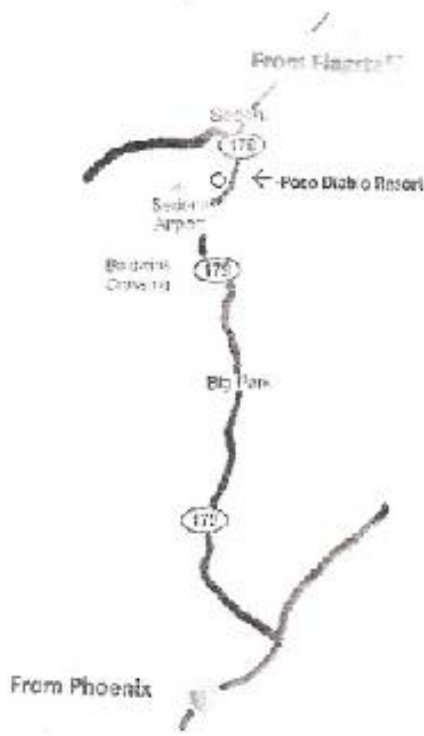

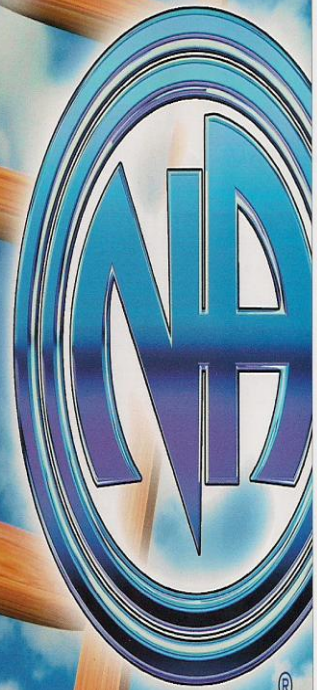
