The Qwest bill was \$58.62 and the Accessline bill was \$92.37 for a total of \$150.99, or \$50.33 per area. The shifts with the greatest need for volunteers are Friday and Saturday mornings, Saturday and Monday afternoons and Sunday night.

More work needs to be done on the 12-step list, and I'm working on an ODT database to merge it with the volunteer list.

We appear to have problems with call routing on Tuesday, so we're going to do some testing between 6AM and 8AM on June 8th to see if we can get a handle on it. We meet that night at 7PM at the Next Coffee Company, 19420 N. 59th Ave, Glendale.

Public Information Subcommittee Report - June 5, 2010

We continue to struggle to develop a PI committee of more than a couple of members. We continue to focus on attracting and recruiting new members. With only 5 people at our meeting this month, we are limited with what so few can accomplish. Nonetheless, here is what we are working on:

Nancy, the PI Committee Co-Chair (who is attending PASC today to represent PI and who is reading this report) has agreed to submit a letter of willingness today to serve as the PR Chair next year. We are VERY happy about that. Nancy has been a member of the PI Committee for at least two years and will bring experience, strength, hope, and skill to the leadership of PR. We are grateful for her.

We have distributed the last of our first round of *Basic Texts*, meeting lists and posters to residential and inpatient addiction treatment centers throughout Phoenix. This is something we hope to maintain as a service to addicts newly entering recovery and as good public relations practice with addiction treatment professionals. Also, Nancy has been attending a Sunnyslope Task Force focused on addiction solutions in that area. In attendance are various probation officers, police officers, hospital social workers, and social workers from other organizations. We hope to form some type of liaison with the JC Lincoln Hospital and Maricopa County Probation so that they provide direct referrals to NA and an addict can actually help them attend their first meetings. This must be coordinated with the phone line's 12th Step list members at a future date, hopefully by summer's end.

We have had some more posters printed in varying sizes to distribute to locations such as TASC, outpatient treatment centers, doctor's offices, hospital ER's, pain management clinics, urgent cares, laundromats, court buildings, jails, convenience stores, and other locations where addicts visit. Nancy has some with her today. If you have a location in mind to hang one or two, please feel free to do so. Grocery stores also have racks near the bulletin boards where meeting lists can be placed. This has been successful in Sunnyslope Fry's stores. Each week we go in, meeting lists are fewer and we refill them. *Just remember that they need to be hung with permission in appropriate locations.* At grocery store bulletin boards or public bulletin boards, they can be hung as a neighborhood announcement without obtaining store permission. An NA sign that attracts negative attention will reflect poorly on NA, so please just be mindful of that.

We are submitting an idea today to change our name from Public Information to "Public Relations." Our committee unanimously voted on this several months ago and we have now made the changes to the Guidelines necessary to present the Idea. This name change bring us in unity with the terminology of World and Regional PR, and better reflects our mission to develop and maintain relationships with people outside the fellowship.

We are continuing to nurture our relationship with Phoenix PD, and hope to develop an alliance with them in the coming months to present NA at various block watch committees. Our immediate future goals include continuing to print and distribute posters to our community, and to print and distribute NA business cards for police vehicles who come in contact with addicts as they arrest/patrol. Many of us sat in the back of squad cars believing there was no solution and we feel that any relationship we can build with Phoenix PD could help us better carry the message. We are working to clear this with the Phoenix PD Neighborhood Patrol Citywide Coordinator.

Our next meeting will be held on the last Sunday of the month which is Sunday June 27 at 5pm at Paradise Bakery on the southwest corner of 12 St & Glendale. It would be really great to see you there! We really need your support! We can't do this alone. See you Sunday June 27, at 5pm.
