Hello Phoenix Area Service Body,

In the past month the Help Line took on one new volunteer, one return volunteer, and two pending new volunteers. I attended East and West Valley Area Service Committees last month. Both are pleased with the operation and support us moving forward with the purchase of an additional SmartOffice in order to reduce shift hours. The Help Line began assisting the Regional Meeting Directory Committee. Now when a Help Line volunteer is notified a meeting is listed incorrectly, either online or in the paper directory, that information is forwarded to the Meeting Directory chairperson. The chairperson verifies the new information is correct before making any changes.

Our previous chairperson, Robin, has continued to be a strong force by lending his expertise and time to this operation. However, the Help Line is in need of a vice chair. A current volunteer has expressed interest for the position and has attended two subcommittee meetings within the last six months. Yet, it remains to be determined if the individual has the available time required for the position.

Public Information Subcommittee Report - August 2010 ✓

We continue to struggle to develop a PI committee of more than a couple of members. At this month's meeting, only two attended, me and another member, who is moving out of state next month. We continue to focus on attracting and recruiting new members. Nonetheless, here is what we are working on.

- The PR Committee Chair is working with JC Lincoln Hospital, as we have reported before. This would entail a post-hospital visit/stay referral to NA where we would work directly with the person rather than have them call the phone line. This could include taking them to a meeting or at least reaching out immediately post visit when people may be amenable to intervention. This meeting should occur within the next two weeks. Scheduling has been problematic.
- In addition, I would like to find someone who does not work days to reach out to Maricopa County Probation in Sunnyslope. If you have any ideas, please let me know. They can also provide direct referrals to NA and an addict can actually help them attend their first meetings. This must be coordinated with the phone line's 12th Step list members at a future date, hopefully by early fall.
- I met with one of the top public relations officers with the Phoenix Police to try to get us in front of the PD and see if they would be willing to carry our cards in their cruisers. We provided NA info packets and cards for the five liaisons to each precinct. She has not gotten back to me yet.
- We also believe that West Valley PR is working on radio spots, but don't have any more information on that at this time.

Our next meeting is on last Sunday of the month, which is Sunday, September 25, at 5pm at Paradise Bakery on the southwest corner of 12 St & Glendale. It would be really great to see you there! We really need your support! We can't do this alone.
