Hello West Valley Service Body,

Last month the Help Line took on two new shift volunteers. There is still a need for a secretary (six month clean time suggestion), and 24 hour rollovers for Monday through Friday (six month clean time requirement and shift experience).

At our subcommittee meeting earlier this week Robin R. stepped up to the vice chair position.

Hey,

I talked with Paul Degan today and promised to send him the new address. He said that he shredded the card information, but if they have had it on file for three years and they're currently using it for billing, then I shouldn't have to send it again, right? Anyway, 800 numbers don't cost any more unless you go over some number of minutes on inbound calls. He said they start charging 4.9 cents per minute after the first 400 minutes on the cheapest plan, or 2.9 cents per minute after 2000 minutes on the plan \$79 plan. Since we get over 600 calls per month and each can last anywhere between a minute and an hour, it might get expensive. 4000 "extra" minutes would cost us an additional \$116 per month, but I really have no clue how many total minutes we currently use and it would vary from month to month. Here's the link to their pricing:

What concerns me on the page this link takes you to is that they say you get 5 menus and 5 hunt groups for free with your plan, and additional menus, hunt groups, extensions and bulletins can be purchase in ten packs for \$5 per month. This does not correspond to what I was told last time we talked with them. We currently have 28 menus and 36 hunt groups, which would mean we should be paying about \$30 more per month than we currently are. Any way you slice it, we probably need something in writing going forward.
