## **RCM II Report November 2010**

### Phoenix Area

There was no Regional meeting in October but I did attend the regional assembly in Cottonwood. The turn out was only fair and the Phoenix area was barely represented. Not sure if it was the venue or the subject matter that kept people away but it was a very good presentation. The topic of discussion was the current Service System Project.

The Service System Project began in 2008 and is an effort to take a look at how we can better provide services in a fellowship that has come so far and changed so much over the years. It is an effort to take a look at what is working and what is not on a local level. The first piece of the project was to create the vision statement that was approved in the 2010 CAR. That statement unites us on a level of service so we have a tangible focal point.

The Project members have put together some ideas of how we can restructure our service system. It is important to remember these are ideas, this is the start of the discussion not a final outcome. The fellowship is asking everyone for input and ideas on how to accomplish better serving on a local level.

It is not my intention to speak abstractly about this issue, so if I had to make a generic summarizing statement to be used as a point to initiate discussion about these models I would say that the ideas is to create a body that strictly deals with the issues of the groups and the direct carrying of our message. This would be called a Group Support Unit. Its purpose would be to make the groups stronger. The Local Service Unit would support the groups and be a leaner administrative body facilitating specific areas of service, perhaps PI, H&I and Phonenumber would meet and take care of business in this forum. The GPU of Geopolitical Unit would perform services on a larger level across an entire state or perhaps an entire nation. We must remember we are a world wide fellowship and need to consider the needs of our brother and sisters across the globe. The GPU could be tasked with meeting list creation, website maintenance and maintaining our legal identity as the Board of Directors of the incorporated Arizona Region does now. And finally Zones. We have eight zones now in the United States. These would take on new functions and there are different options for their use to the service structure. Our representatives to the conference would be elected at this level. Ultimately this reduces our representation to from 114 to 16. The sErvice System Project is looking for ways to make the World Conference more productive as well as

affordable. Right now the US has 114 or the 165 delegates. This is just something that is being rethought. So there you have the gist of it. Input is due by December 31. There is a wealth of information on the world web site including discussion groups, power point presentations and handouts with the history of the project and the current proposed models.

The RCM and I are available to answer questions and come to your group business meetings if you need any help sorting through the information.

I am attaching some documents that are available on the world website for your reference.

The NA Way will be available for free by way of PDF and email. If you choose to subscribe to a hard copy there will be a \$13 per year charge. Not sure when this is starting but I believe it is Jan. 1, 2011.

There is also a new literature survey available on line. Please encourage all your homegroup members to access it and speak up about our literature needs. It can be completed by mail as well.

Help Line Report  
November 6, 2010

Hello Phoenix Area Service Body,

Last month the Help Line took on two new shift volunteers, one new rollover, and Robin accepted the vice-chair position. The secretary position on our subcommittee is open, 24 hour rollover positions for Tuesday through Friday are open, and two volunteers for the Monday 6am-noon shift are needed.

The purchase of an additional SmartOffice is complete. Robin and another volunteer will soon begin building the new SmartOffice for three hour shifts and record new prompts for callers.

I did attend BluesFest however I did not go early and I did not set up a booth. I made a tri-fold presentation board and got one new volunteer from that display.

I contacted the South Central Help Line Chair, Valerie D., and she wasn't interested in merging with our tri-area Help Line. She was willing to gather the average number of minutes they use for incoming calls and discuss the idea at their next Area meeting two weeks from now. She expressed a geographic concern regarding helping addicts find a nearby meeting because South Central is so far apart from Metro Phoenix. Valerie stated their Help Line is running well, they don't need or want to go high tech, and they have been affording their expenses for the last 13 years. She also stated she's seen this type of merger happen before and it didn't work well. I believe it would be a huge project management task to bring in South Central to create a quad-area Help Line. I see no reason to move forward on this if their area isn't requesting it.

Concerning changing the Tri-Area Help Line number to a toll free number, there is no cost to switch numbers and it would be the same package price as our current local number. It appears the only limitation of having a toll free number is we are capped at 2000 minutes per month for incoming calls. An additional charge of 2.9 cents per minute would accrue beyond 2000 minutes. I tallied the incoming call minutes for the last six months and found we went over 2000 minutes in July by 241 minutes, August 129 minutes, and September 653 minutes. At our peak we're looking at about \$19 extra dollars.

Our next subcommittee meeting will be Tuesday November 9th at 7pm in Glendale at Next Coffee Co: 19420 N. 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue, intersection of Utopia. You do not have to attend a subcommittee meeting to be a phone shift volunteer but must meet the 6 month clean time requirement. 24 hour rollovers do not need to attend either but must have at least 6 months clean and Help Line volunteer experience. Anyone interested in the secretary position please attend the subcommittee meeting.
