## **Subject: Update about NA Way subscriptions**

Greetings all – As you may remember, discussions at the last World Service Conference resulted in some very important changes to subscriptions to The NA Way Magazine. Those changes will impact the upcoming January 2011 edition of the magazine. We are writing to remind you about these changes and ask you to remind members in your communities of them as well, so that everyone is able to take the action necessary to receive their NA Way without interruption.

As we've been announcing since the conference, no one, including NA groups will continue to automatically receive a paper subscription to The NA Way. The recent October 2010 edition of the magazine was the final automatic mailing from the existing database. As an alternative, individuals, groups, or service committees can receive either e-subscriptions of the magazine or paper copies if they need them. Of course, we are trying to save NA funds wherever we can and electronic subscriptions are a good way to do that, but we also realize that many people either do not have access to a computer or cannot navigate our site in English. We are continuing to translate the magazine into French, Portuguese, German, Spanish, Russian, and Farsi. Of course we want to continue to communicate and even to improve our abilities to reach addicts, but our economic reality is forcing us to find more cost effective ways to do so.

If someone already has an e-subscription he or she will continue to receive the magazine. Those who have been receiving a paper copy must re-subscribe for either an e-sub, or a paper copy if they feel they need it. Our subscription page requires a log on which must be done by an individual. Here is a link to our subscriptions page:

<http://www.na.org/subscribe>. Committees or groups should use the "multiple-copy subscription" link to subscribe.

We are asking members to remember that choosing the electronic subscription reduces distribution costs, saving fellowship funds for other uses, and offers access to additional content and features not available in the paper version. If an individual, group, or service committee needs multiple paper copies, it is typically much more cost effective for us to mail these in bulk subscriptions rather than mailing several separate envelopes. For bulk subscriptions, you can email [fsmail@na.org](mailto:fsmail@na.org) or go to <http://www.na.org/subscribe> and use the "multiple-copy subscription" link.

Finally, we have given current delegates and alternates an e-sub to the English NA Way. If you need a paper copy or wish to make other choices, you can either go to the subscription page or email [Elaine@na.org](mailto:Elaine@na.org) as your delegate contact or [fsmail@na.org](mailto:fsmail@na.org) and we will be glad to help you.

All changes seem to have an adjustment period and we are sure this will be no different. We really need your help to reach members to get the message out.

Hello family!

The November issue is ready to go. As a reminder, there are two copies for each homegroup, and one for each administrative committee member and sub-committee chair. I encourage you to make copies for your homegroup.

Last month, an idea request was submitted that was referred to our committee. It reads as follows: "to include an conference approved NA logo on our West Valley Newsletter for easy identification that it is a Narcotics Anonymous Newsletter."

The intention of the request is: "to aid in the easy identification of our newsletter and events flyers as NA literature and events."

This presents a slight problem. When we created the newsletter guidelines, we were very careful to leave no room for commentary, editorials or Q & A. As a result, the guidelines are very specific. They allow us only: "to supply information about meeting changes, service opportunities, and NA events in a clear, easy-to-read format." (page 1, second paragraph, letter B)

To carry out the idea request that was submitted last month, I suggest that we add a second idea request, first, to change the guidelines, and second, to spell out exactly what will be printed in the newsletter. One suggestion is to state:

"The WVASC requests that all flyers display a conference-approved logo per idea request # \_\_\_\_\_ from the November 2010 Area meeting."

What we print is a reflection on the West Valley, and I feel that it is too important an issue to not take the time to send it back to the homegroups. I've requested time for more discussion in the Open Forum later in the meeting.

I promised last month to have a sample this month, and I am happy to say that we were able to put a conference-approved NA logo on the newsletter. If you notice, we decided not to put the NA watermark on the front page because it just looked too busy, but there is an NA logo on the top left and a watermark on every page after that. Please let me know if you have any feedback.

I was contacted by someone working with the webservant this month about posting the service positions available in the West Valley. After getting the thumb's up from John, I sent her the requirements straight from the guidelines, and they are now available on the website. If someone is interested, they are requested to attend the Area meeting. No names or contact numbers are listed.
