Help Line Report
December 17, 2010

In November the Help Line didn't take on any new volunteers but we did lose two. The secretary position on our subcommittee is still open. The good news is we filled 24 hour rollover positions for Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday at the beginning of December; leaving only the Thursday rollover position open. Current phone shift openings are Monday 6am-noon, Tuesday 6am-noon, and Wednesday 6am-noon.

A trusted servant is still needed to fill the open area liaison position to communicate the WVASC group conscience to the Help Line subcommittee. This individual will also be the link between Help Line volunteers/NA members stating meeting list changes and the Regional Directory Committee. The clean time requirement is determined by the WVASC and at this time nominees need to have knowledge of the NA service structure, familiarity with the processes of the WVASC, frequent email access, and be able to attend the monthly Help Line subcommittee meeting.

Our second SmartOffice is not ready to be rolled out yet.

I followed up with Valerie D. Help Line chair for South Central about merging with our tri-area Help Line. She brought it up to her area in November and informed me they do not wish to make that change.

In regard to the toll-free number research, it appears the only limitation of having a toll free number is a 2000 minute cap per month for incoming calls. An additional charge of 2.9 cents per minute will accrue. As requested by the PASC, I tallied the incoming call minutes for the entire last year.

A previous Help Line chair suggested I contact Qwest to find out if they will print a toll-free number assigned from an outside company. I have not done that yet. A GSR vote needs to take place in order to set in motion the toll-free number change for our tri-area Help Line.

Hello the Fellowship

I'm an addict named Cliff.

I'm here today to talk to you about our fellowship. It starts with the addict, then homegroup, then area's, then region, and of course at last to World. We at Region need your help. Part of our current service structure is holding Regional assembly's where the GSR'S show up to give their direct input to our RD's. We need the GSR's to show up and participate in these assemblies.

In The Group Booklet, under Group Service Representative's, it reads that "GSR's form the foundation of our service structure. GSR's provide constant, active influence over the discussions being carried on within the service structure. They do this by participating in area service committee meetings, attending forums and assemblies at both the area and regional levels, and sometimes joining in the work of an ASC subcommittee." It goes on to say that, "Group service representatives bear great responsibility. While GSR's are elected by and accountable to the group, they are not mere group messengers. They are selected by their groups to serve as active members of the area service committee. As such, they are responsible to act in the best interests of NA as a whole, not solely as advocates of their own group's priorities."

We are currently in discussion about changing our service structure. WE NEED YOUR INPUT!!!! At the last few years worth of assemblies we are lucky to get 25% of the GSR's from their respective Area's there. If you will not participate in the current service structure as it is I beg you to get involved now so that WE can come up with something that the Fellowship will participate in. This is being discussed on the World site as well as the RCM's have the information that we are going over.

I know to what ends I went to too stay high. To what ends I ask you, the HOMEGROUPS, are you willing to go to, to make this Fellowship work so that the addict who still suffers has a place to go.

The next Assembly will be March 12 in Tucson. Gsr's receive gas reimbursement for travel to this event, if you travel 150 miles round trip. But we do encourage carpooling to keep Regional expenses down. I will be going myself with room for a couple more.
