Help Line Report

January 15, 2011

In December the Help Line took on one new volunteer and three existing volunteers stepped up for more shifts. Our secretary position and Thursday rollover shift is still open. The greatest need for shift volunteers is on Wednesday 6am-noon and noon-6pm. Other available shifts are Monday 6am-noon, and Tuesday 6am-noon.

A trusted servant is still needed to fill the open area liaison position to communicate the WVASC group conscience to the Help Line subcommittee. This individual will also be the link between Help Line volunteers/NA members stating meeting list changes and the Regional Directory Committee. The clean time requirement is determined by the WVASC and at this time nominees need to have knowledge of the NA service structure, familiarity with the processes of the WVASC, frequent email access, and be able to attend the monthly Help Line subcommittee meeting.

Our second SmartOffice is not ready to be rolled out yet.

I contacted one representative at Qwest, the current Help Line phone number provider. The cost for listing an outside company's toll free number is \$4.75 per month. So it seems we can replace our Qwest service with a toll free number through AccessLine. A GSR vote needs to take place in order to set in motion the toll-free number change.

The Help Line budget was due at this month's PASC meeting. I submitted it and GSRs will vote on it in February. The 2011 budget requests WVASC reimburse PASC \$632.00 which is 1/3 of the contracted costs of the AccessLine and Qwest bills. A question arose about WVASC splitting the total cost of the Help Line operation by 1/3 instead of just the contracted costs. Can WVASC afford to reimburse PASC \$1065.00 over the course of 2011? If so, I will revise and resubmit the budget to PASC.

Our next subcommittee meeting will be held at Denny's, 3456 W. Bethany Home Rd., on Tuesday February 8th. For those who wish to buy dinner and socialize before we get down to business please show up at 6:30 pm. The meeting will be from 7-8 pm. You do not have to attend a subcommittee meeting to be a phone shift volunteer or a 24 hour rollover but it would be nice to have you there.
