Since this event is not being coordinated by any duly elected representative or registered area, region, or zone we are not really comfortable commenting. There are issues that are raised in their material about NAWS and those questions we are happy to respond to. A United States conference is not an idea that we believe will help us better achieve our primary purpose or we would have included it in the Service System proposals. As always, we are open to your concerns, ideas, and comments.
