Region met in March and here are some highlights:

The Web Servant shall be a standing committee and no longer under the wing of PR.

We seeded ½ of ½ of the Festival of Recovery seed money and Navapache will make up the rest of the funds.

We agreed to purchase a new credit card machine for the Region and there was a break in to our storage shed and one of the two machines was hijacked. Not sure were the other machine was at the time.

We agreed to obtain another key to the regional post office box as we apparently only had 1 and the Behind the Walls chair grew weary of retrieving all of the mail. (She picks it up on her lunch hour and there has been more than once when the box was full and she had to stand in line and that takes significantly longer then the hour she has for lunch)

ARCNA elections will be held next session and we have 3 service resumes attached for your review. Please discuss them with your home group and be ready to give me your input next month at area.

Our RD's attended the zonal forum and Alaska attended via SKYPE, there was much discussion regarding the changes to the service structure.

EVNA RCMII report for April 2011

Greetings family hope all is well, South Central was very happy to introduce themselves as the new Regional Volleyball Champs and report that they are getting more involved with the upcoming TSLD and voted to give 20% of their 7th tradition to region though that is a continuing topic. As a side note Paul W was in contact with me in regards to finding a location in the East Valley to hold the TSLD to accommodate South Central as where I put him in contact with Scott K about securing Word of Grace as a location.

South Eastern Area reports a balance of \$3,048.35 due to a high budget to cover their expenses over the next few months but does donate by mail periodically. They have a new PR chair and are looking at doing PSA's for their Area. Their Activities committee has announce the beginning of their BBQ season and welcome anyone in their area to look them up at www.natucson.org and join in as they are free due to the large amount of newcomers in their area. They had one meeting fold but did have 35 out of 44 groups at their Area and an ad-hoc committee was to meet 3/26 for a guideline review. H&I are looking to scan their guidelines and emailing to their members and are planning a TSLD in June in Sierra Vista. Phone line is also planning a learning day for their members. Their Literature is asking their groups to pay with money orders to keep from handling so much cash. They reported that they were going to ask Region for funds to do a GSR workshop in May to go over their responsibilities and the new service structure as we would all like more detail on that topic but I don't see a request was ever submitted.

Phoenix Area reports that they continue to hold monthly dances and are picking up more support by having speakers from other Areas. Their phone line is looking for a secretary and the PR committee is putting a letter together outlining our 12th step call process. They are still working on getting more tri Area support for the 800#. Also they are working on getting business cards out to Phoenix police cars for referrals and on pooling the tri Area monies for PSA's. Help Line Report
April 10, 2011

The Help Line took on three new volunteers last month, two of which had to step down due to illness. Current open shifts are: Monday 6am-noon, Wednesday 6am-noon and Wednesday noon-6pm. Our secretary position is still open, suggested clean time is six months. I intend to fill this position when my term as chair is over, if no one else has stepped up by then.

The new version of SmartOffice doesn't have all the features to support as many shifts as we need after all. Another company needs to be found if we still wish to have three hour shifts. Robin and I are going to research other hosted voice over IPs so we can have leverage when requesting a refund from AccessLine for the money we wasted on the second SmartOffice. (\$435.20) At West Valley Area Angie M. was unanimously voted in as Help Line Liaison. I attended their Area Service Committee last month and was able to clarify the cost of bills and how it would change if we switched to a toll free number through AccessLine. Their service body wants more information about the toll free number before they vote on it. They'd like to know if the rate is competitive, what area codes will be able to utilize the number, and if we can choose our own number to spell out a phrase.

The Help Line event went well on March 20th. We had ten volunteers show up at 11am to set up. The start time was 1pm and people were so eager they started showing up a half hour early; by 1pm there were already 35 people in attendance. There was plenty of food and drinks with little left over. \$119 was donated during the BBQ. Three people stepped up to take phone line shifts. The speaker meeting had 37 people in attendance and \$66.55 was collected in 7th Tradition.

Our next subcommittee meeting will be held at Denny's, 3456 W. Bethany Home Rd., on Tuesday April 12th. For those who wish to buy dinner and socialize before we get down to business please show up by 6:30 pm. The meeting will be from 7-8 pm, everyone is welcome to attend.
