Help Line Report April 16, 2011

The Help Line took on three new volunteers last month, two of which had to step down due to illness. Current open shifts are: Mon/Tue/Wed 6am-noon, Tue/Wed/Thur/Sat noon-6pm, Wed 6pm-midnight, and a Monday 24 hour rollover. Our secretary position is still open, suggested clean time is six months. I intend to fill this position when my term as chair is over, if no one else has stepped up by then.

After numerous attempts to build a second SmartOffice for three hour shifts, Robin has found it doesn't have all the features to support as many shifts as we need, at the current price. Additional packages of certain features needed are available in \$5 increments from AccessLine. Robin and I are researching other web routing companies and considering requesting a refund from AccessLine for the money wasted on the second SmartOffice, which is \$435.20.

A toll free number through AccessLine would be national. Robin and I are looking into toll free numbers with the new companies we're researching. In East Valley Area news, the motion to not fund 1/3 of WSLD expenses was passed.

The Help Line event on March 20th went well. We had ten volunteers to set up. At 1pm there were already 35 people in attendance. There was plenty of food and drinks with little left over. \$119 was donated during the BBQ. Three people stepped up to take phone line shifts. The speaker meeting had 37 people in attendance and \$66.55 was collected in 7th Tradition.

Our next subcommittee meeting will be held at Denny's, 3456 W. Bethany Home Rd., on Tuesday May 10th. For those who wish to buy dinner and socialize before we get down to business please show up by 6:30 pm. The meeting will be from 7-8 pm. Phone shift volunteers are not required to attend but all are welcome.
