Help Line Report

May 21, 2011

The Help Line took on two new volunteers in April but several more phone shifts opened up: Monday 6am-noon, Tuesday noon-6pm, **Wednesday noon-6pm**, Thursday noon-6pm, Friday 6am-noon, and Friday 6pm-midnight all need help. We are also seeking a 24 hour Rollover for Mondays. The right volunteer for this commitment needs to be available to take calls as a back up from 12 am to 11:59 pm every Monday, preferably with six months prior phone shift experience.

Trusted servants are still needed for the East and West Valley Area Liaison positions, clean time requirements are determined by their Areas. Our Secretary position is still open, suggested clean time is six months. In order to serve on the subcommittee volunteers must also take a phone shift.

Robin attended PASC and submitted his statement of willingness for the chair position.

Pertaining to AccessLine, Robin tried to make contact several times with alternative providers, Onebox and directconnect.com, but had no luck.

I researched Onebox, FreedomVoice, and VoiceShot. VoiceShot is the only other provider offering what we currently receive from AccessLine but VoiceShot is \$125 more expensive per month. Even AccessLine doesn't offer what we have with them on any of their current plans. If we drop our current account with AccessLine we lose.

Therefore, Robin and I are in agreement to cut our losses now by cancelling the second SmartOffice account we've been trying to build for three hour shifts. We also agree it's best to drop the Qwest number we're paying \$58 for every month and have our AccessLine phone number printed on meeting lists and other NA hand out materials. For a \$10 activation fee plus \$5 per month AccessLine can list the number with 411 which will be printed in the local white pages. This will save our Tri-Areas \$126 in Help Line expenses per month. We will only have one bill for \$103 a month. Remember our slogan, "Keep it simple".

I have already submitted an online cancellation request for the second SmartOffice to our sales representative at AccessLine. Their customer service department emailed me back they want to try to help us achieve our three hour shift goal but its unclear what exactly they're offering to do. Robin followed up with the customer service department making a second request to cancel the account and explained the issue with their service.

I was only able to gather one more piece of information concerning the toll free number, which is, AccessLine provides international toll free numbers.

Our next subcommittee meeting will be held at Denny's, 3456 W. Bethany Home Rd., on Tuesday June 14th. For those who wish to buy dinner and socialize before we get down to business please show up by 6:30 pm. The meeting will be from 7-8 pm. You do not have to attend a subcommittee meeting to be a phone shift volunteer but everyone is welcome.
