

The Help Line took on five new volunteers in May and one volunteer stepped up for the Monday Rollover shift. We can still use more help on: Monday 6am-noon, Tuesday noon-6pm, Wednesday noon-6pm, Thursday noon-6pm, and there's room for one more Monday Rollover.

Trusted servants are still needed for the East and West Valley Area Liaison positions, clean time requirements are determined by their Areas. Our Secretary position is still open, suggested clean time is six months. In order to serve on the subcommittee volunteers must also take a phone shift. Please support your NA friends to be of service.

Robin had further correspondence with AccessLine's customer service and successfully suspended our second SmartOffice account. The savings is reflected on May's bill.

Robin and I agree it's best to drop the Qwest number we're paying \$58 for every month and instead have our AccessLine phone number printed on meeting lists and other NA hand out materials. For a \$10 activation fee plus \$5 per month AccessLine can list their number with 411 which will be printed in our local white pages. We would only have one bill for roughly \$103 a month. Remember our slogan, "Keep it simple". **Please take this idea back to your home groups for discussion.**

Now that I'm not tied up with the system change proposal I can focus on our subcommittee guidelines, calling the shift volunteers to make sure everything is running smoothly, and continue to assist new volunteers.
