It's been a comparatively active 2 months, rife with learning.

- PO Box key update: I currently have the key to our ARSCNA PO Box and have checked it weekly. So far it has been easy to distinguish Behind The Walls mail intended for H&I and other ARSCNA stuff. The non-H&I items: Google advertisement, the Directories invoice (which I scanned and emailed to the Directories Chair and Treasurer), and 2 checks which were given to the Treasurer. RECOMMENDATION: Annually record and report the name of the key-holder.
- In an attempt to provide timely information to the RCM's, I sent Lucky's Statement of Willingness (SOW), which was submitted after ARSC met in May, to run for the Convention Vice-Chair. The May ARSC meeting where we voted to elect Bernie as Vice-Chair for ARCNA generated much discussion at the time, and apparently subsequent confusion. Should I have an opportunity to communicate with you all in the future I will first make sure we have the same understanding.
- Another email exchange was an act fulfilling my duty as Vice-Chair, reminding everyone the budgets needed to be in-- RCM's were included as a reminder to look for, or ask for, them at July ARSC, and to the existing/exiting Chairs for obvious reasons. The task has been accomplished, all budgets have been submitted, but it seems there may be questions about the budget review process we have been using over the years. It is my hope that you all find (found) time to review the current process and determine if and what changes need to be made.
- My next to last task was to assist in preparing the Administrative budget. In that process I discovered (rediscovered) a way to enhance our current Treasurer Report to include and reflect budget items - if I can make sense of it I am sure anyone can.
- My final task is to assist with the audit before the next group of leaders take office which will be on a weekend sometime in August.

Thank you for allowing me to be at your side as we serve NA and for providing me with, probably inadvertently, many learning opportunities.

I wish you all well in your journeys and hope our paths will cross, but not necessarily be cross when they do.

RD report July 2011

Good Afternoon,

My Thanks to the ARCNA 25 committee for another great event and looking forward to ARCNA26.

One thing that you should look at is having the RD team do interactive workshops at the conventions. Many of the other Regions are using this to get information that the workgroups user for the current projects.

Service System Update from the March 2011 proposal some of the highlights are

Variations: Some communities may decide to have GSU meetings less often (every other month instead of every month) to ease the strain on human resources. Small communities may even decide to alternate GSU meetings and LSU meetings, or to devote the first half of a service meeting to the GSU and the second half to the LSU. In most places, there will be several GSUs for each LSU, but in the rare case of small or rural communities, the populations may be roughly the same. In a rural part of a state where there are, for instance, eight meetings in a given county, those same eight meetings may gather to coordinate county-wide services and to discuss group needs. It's important to note that this would be exceptional.

Regardless of which option a community chooses, two ways to improve communication and strengthen the link between the group and the service structure are to utilize technology and to attend the annual assembly. Throughout the system, we could use information technology (IT) more effectively to distribute information and discuss ideas. And the annual planning assembly described below offers a forum for all interested members in a local community to gather and discuss issues and set priorities; both groups and GSUs would send a delegate to the planning assembly.

Jim and I would like to attend each of your area meetings to talk about the proposed changes to the service system.

SWANA has asked that we come down and do another learning day with them in either October or November.

Attended the recent learning day held in the Valley it had a good turn out as TSKD's go. We ended the day with a QA on the service system proposal.

The office sent out new IDT's they are on the new IP's that were approved at the last conference. I checked with the office on the cost of the CAR report. They are thinking of \$8.00 to \$12.00 depending on the size. WE will have more information hopefully by November. If the budget is approved we are going to order 1 copy for each RCM and RCM2. They will be ordered as soon as they come out and shipped to each RCM1.

On the budget we were going over it and we think that \$250.00 is a little much for lunch. It seems that the lunches are getting to be a battle to see who can out do the last one. WE are suggesting that food be changed to \$200.00 this will save \$150.00 this year. This can buy about 100 Into guide at the old price, We as a fellowship need to look at how and where the monies are being spent. In our budget we also

have a World Wide workshop for \$2000.00 I do not see one this year. They are important since the RD team is trained with the latest information that we need to train you the RCM's. Again this year we are asking to purchase a projector so we can better train and present to the fellowship. A projector rents for \$150.00 per day. Since we have events on Saturday that would be \$300.00 per event and this year we will be having three of them.

On the October Assembly I have been working with the Vice chair of the YASC and have not heard back on the time. I contacted Randy B to help with this. Once this is done I hope within the next week we be making flyers and mailing to you for your areas.

I am still working on the RBZ Rationale Questionnaire for Gregg and Nancy should be finished by the end of the month.

- Add a Regional Assembly, One in January and one in March to go over the conference agenda on conference years so that the GSR's can bring back input (Request 5/17/09)

SITE LOCATION REPORT

The hotel contract for ARCNA XVI has been signed and delivered. The hotel is the "Doubletree Resort by Hilton Paradise Valley – Scottsdale. No other hotel was as responsive or receptive as the Doubletree.

The other hotels were the Hyatt in downtown Phoenix the room rate was higher and parking was an issue. I did not look into the Marriott facility in Mesa because of the limited amount of space. I met with the

Scottsdale Plaza Resort and could not get the room rates down and the banquet cost was an issue. I did not go back to the newer hotels on the two reservations because of I wasn't sure that the fellowship was ready to go back to a facility that had gaming.

The Doubletree accepted the hold harmless waiver so that the hospitality room can be held in a public room on the first floor near the restaurant and entrance to one of the two pools. The board submitted a credit application so that a deposit will not be necessary. The room block was reduced to 225 room nights, and the first room cutoff date is May 4, 2012 with an extension if the block isn't met and if the block is met we will still get credit up to the day of the event. Meals will be negotiated with catering services and the fellowship should decide as soon as possible if having a breakfast is a good idea. Over the years the attendance has dropped for the breakfast. The convention committee will have access to the boardroom on a monthly basis up to the start of the convention; at that point it will be the executive office for the convention committee and a secured room.

**ARIZONA REGIONAL ACTIVITIES
Sub-Committee Guidelines**

ARTICLE 1 PURPOSE:

- A. To support areas within this region in carrying the message of NA, by promoting unity through communication, funds (i.e. grants, seed money, merchandise) and sharing experience, strength and hope.
- B. To host the UNITY DAY CAMPOUT at a campsite located in the State of Arizona. Until such times when different AREAS get involved, then the decision shall be made from all the RCM's and their perspective AREAs as to who will host the campout each year.
- C. To allow input from all areas in the Arizona Region of Narcotics Anonymous.

ARTICLE 2 MEMBERSHIP AND OPERATIONS:

- A. The ARIZONA REGIONAL ACTIVITIES (ARA) shall be comprised of, and open to all interested members and trusted servants in the NA fellowship. Membership in the ARAC shall be limited to members of NA.
- B. A committee member shall become a voting member of the ARA after making a verbal commitment to service before the committee. Commitment to service shall entail regular attendance at the ARA and responsibility to accepted tasks. Each voting member, except the chair, shall have one vote. The chair votes only in case of a tie. A maximum of two votes per area will be allowed.
- C. The ARA will hold regular meetings quarterly at the Regional Service Meeting. Special meetings may be called by a simple majority vote or at the request of the chair.
- D. Contracts involving the ARA shall be signed by a duly appointed representative member of the **BOARD OF TRUSTIES for the ARIZONA REGIONAL SERVICE COMMITTEE (ARSC)**.

- F. All requests for monies need to be presented at the ARSC meeting and approved by the ARSC. This money will be considered seed money.
- G. All checks for seed money are to be written to a committee or group (not to individuals). The seed money must be deposited into a two signature checking account.
- H. A close out report of the event shall be submitted to the ARSC.
