Additionally, after the vote at ASC to take possession of the Bluesfest checkbook, Joe A., Cheryl W. and I attended the Bluesfest committee the Thursday following ASC, July 14th, and I am now in possession of the checkbook. I have received all the bank statements dating back to last December 2010 with a beginning balance of the seed money, \$2700. There was no activity on the account through the May 2011 bank statement, with beginning and ending balances remaining at \$2700. I am sending the last 2 months bank statements, June and July 2011, to Wild Bill for inclusion in this month's minutes. In these last 2 months, money has been spent for T-shirts, flyers and the quilt to be raffled or auctioned. I'm not sure which. Additionally, the money deposited for T-shirt sales checks against the report I heard at the Bluesfest meeting. That was \$707 total with \$154 turned in at the meeting for a total of deposits in the checking account on the bank statements of \$553. In short, all is well with Bluesfest finances. At the Bluesfest sub-committee meeting, all of their service positions were filled including Treasurer, clearing the way for us to return their checkbook to them at the next ASC, group conscience permitting of course.
