Our summer has slowed to a crawl, but here is what is in the works for a busy fall as we welcome three new PR member this month and next.

- ✓ JC Lincoln has the finished brochure. The brochure is designed to be given to addicts who are either admitted or come into the emergency room at the hospital, which refers them to NA. We await the administrator's approval but this may not occur for a few more months. In the meanwhile, I would like to contact another valley hospital to try to do this same process at their facility, as well.
- ✓ We are still working to get our NA business cards in Phoenix Police Department vehicles. Committee members contacted three divisions but I need people who have flexible work hours who can visit the precincts during the day to meet with police community liaison officers. I think one of our new members may be able to do that.
- ✓ We are planning a fall flyer day where we blanket Phoenix with NA posters (small) and business cards, followed by ~~pizza party at a local establishment. Can we use PR budget funds for an event of this nature?~~ *potluck park*
- ✓ It's that time again—time to get Basic Texts and It Works...distributed to halfway houses in Phoenix, so we'll be requesting literature this month or next. One of the habitual problems of our PR committee is the lack of record transition from one Chair to the next. We did this two years ago, but I don't have the list of the local halfway houses. I will work with our regional PR Chair to redevelop a list.
- ✓ The radio spots for a summer radio campaign I believe have ended. I will meet with Robin today to determine how many calls came from the spots before we invest further.
- ✓ I was informed by Patte that it is not in our guidelines for me to attend the learning conference, only the PR chair. It is in my budget. I would like some discussion, although air fares now will be higher.
- ✓ I attended the Drug Court presentation on PR at World and it was amazing. The two judges who started Drug Court in CA regions spoke and it makes me think: Are we effectively working with Drug Courts here? Does this body know of anyone who liaises with Drug Court for the Phoenix area? If not, we should be talking to the Maricopa County judges both on the municipal court and superior court level.

Identification of realistic Prudent Reserve figures

To the members of the Phoenix Area Service Committee (PASC), thank you for the opportunity to be of service. To the Ad Hoc Committee members, thank you for your diligence, input and service on this committee. Finally, thank you Merry M., PASC Treasurer, for maintaining historical and current PASC financial records and working for clarity and understanding of these records with this committee.

Findings:

- Complete and accurate financial records are maintained and reported
- Report formatting has been inconsistent, difficult to read or understand
- Actual spending is usually less than budgeted

Solutions / Suggestions: Revise forms, reporting formats – more user friendly, improved clarity / understanding.

- Return to twelve vs current three month “Budget vs. Actual” report – provides for improved tracking of finances
- Change “Annual” column heading to “Year to Date” and center category headings to highlight the individual categories – provides for easier review of categories
- Provide last 3 years actual budget figures – expenses and income - for review to set new year budget
- Revise budget worksheet – include projected income

3 year budgets review indicates the suggestion to bring budgets in line with our spending and income. Revise reports / forms for clarity and improved understanding. Offer more user friendly budget preparation and help as requested from the administrative officers i.e. Vice Chair, Treasurer. Prepare a prudent and reasonable PASC budget for review and approval from the Area.
