CHAIR REPORT
OCTOBER 15, 2011**

WVASC Chair activities are as follows:

Went to the bank and signed the signature card for the Area Activities Committee. While I was there I had a long conversation regarding the charges for rolled change and loose change. There is a \$.06 charge for each roll of coins. Then if the deposit has any loose change an additional \$10.00 fee is charged to the account. The bank representative discussed some ways to avoid these charges. As a trusted servant of the executive committee I discussed this with the Vice Chair and the Secretary. We felt that we should not be depositing loose change because as the outgoing treasurer reported this would never be more than \$17.00 and in fact less than that, but we are giving that money to the bank in the \$10.00 fee. So I am willing whenever possible to buy the change from the Treasurer prior to deposit. The Vice Chair is buying a box to keep the extra change in between area so that there will no longer be any loose change deposited.

In addition the three of us got together to balance the checkbook and discovered that the way we calculated the Prudent Reserve was actually reserving the expenses for the WSLD attendance by subcommittees twice. When we change the calculation in order to not do this we found that our prudent reserve would be reduced by \$204.00.

Let me give a brief explanation. When we calculate the prudent reserve the budgets include the WSLD cost so that dollar amount is being held in the prudent reserve, then in addition each month another 12th of that amount is added to funds on hold. So the prudent reserve calculation should be adjusted to first subtract any budget amounts that are on hold, and then divided by 6 to have our prudent reserve to be two months of expenses, and then each month the additional funds will be added to the funds on hold.

I was unable to attend subcommittee meetings due to illness and automobile accidents will do better this month life willing.

Thank you Bret for going to Region for the Area. That was a big support to executive committee.

Hope that we fill some positions today during elections or at least receive some statements of willingness.

Please remember as we look for addicts to serve that there is 1 year service experience at area level, this would include being on any area service committee.

I have not updated the World Area Registration Form yet if no new additions today will do that this month.
