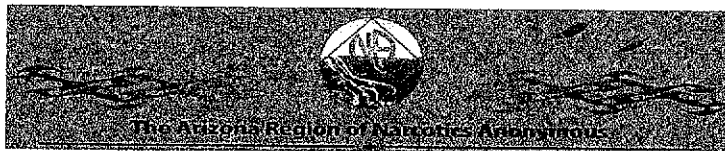

RCM Forum -- I hope you all had a chance to attend the RCM Forum ... I recognize that it adds additional time away from your other activities. This is where the dialogue occurs regarding items that may or will be presented at ARSC. I would like to suggest that you connect with an RCM who did attend the Forum for a brief recap before ARSC meets. This will facilitate our meeting and assure we are out of the room in a timely manner for the next group who meets here.

Minutes -- Thanks to our Secretary who was able to get our minutes posted rapidly. Please review the minutes and advise the Secretary promptly of any changes (such as roll call attendance).

Regional Assembly -- Due to misunderstandings, and in spite of the Yavapai Activities Chair's tireless efforts attempting to land a new location for the meeting, we had to cancel GSR Regional Assembly scheduled to meet in October. You all did an excellent job in spreading the word to your GSR's. Because this is the first time this has occurred it seems the best action to take is a review of procedures and an emphasis on communication with the RD Team. Service System

Living Clean

Material discussing our literature development process and the approval draft of Living Clean. This is a yes no vote

FIPT motions

We are offering motions related to electronic enhancements, bundling of NA literature, and corrections to existing material.

WCNA rotation

We are proposing changing the convention from every two years to every three years after 2015 and changing the rotation pattern.

IDTs

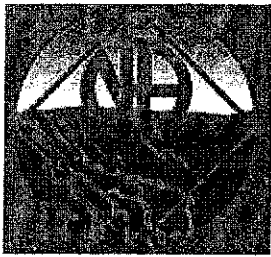
Regional Proposals

In NA we all volunteer as trusted servants, none of us get a paycheck for the hours we put in. Sometimes the things we plan don't go the way we plan them. One of the events that didn't come off as planned was our last Regional Assembly. All of the people involved did everything they could to make it happen. When it was determined the event couldn't be held every effort was made to notify everyone we could. Our Regional Chair even chose to spend the day at the site the Assembly was to be held to inform people who didn't get the message.

Because of the importance of the material we were going to be covering, The RD and I met with the Chair and Vice Chair to arrange make up assemblies. We discussed several options that would fit with Kens and my schedules. Both of our work schedules are very heavy during the months of Nov and Dec but we felt every GSR should have the opportunity to be able to present their Groups with all of the material we will be covering at the CAR workshop next year.

Our visit to South West Area was very productive, their TSLD format works very well and their holding it in a detox center really gives a great perspective to a learning day. We took advantage of the opportunity to do an abbreviated version of our Service Structure presentation. It was well received.

ARSC Treasure Report

The October 31, 2011 reconciled balance is \$2,665.18 which is approximately \$4,500 less than last year. Even without the \$1,000 loan to the Blues Fest, the balance is still \$3,500 below last year. The balance last October was \$7,161.81. The current balance in the regional account is \$1,640.70. I have included the September and October Account Summary in my report.

I have also included as an attachment to this report is the year to date expenses for each sub-committee and the remaining funds as compared to the approved budgets. The \$1000.00 advance to the Blues Fest is charged to administration but this will be reversed once the loan is repaid.

I have submitted a receipt for \$29.33 for treasure supplies. I purchased a receipt book, large envelopes and stamps.

I am concerned that we may not be able to pay all our expenses in the coming months. As stated above our balance is \$3,500 below last year's. The revenue in September was less this year than last by approximately \$350. Last November the donations received was approximately \$6,300. I am hopeful that the donations this month will equal or exceed last year's, but if they fall short we will need to make some tough decisions on what expenses to cut or possibly delay payment to. The BOD bill of approximately \$5,000 to \$6,000 is due in January so we need to set money aside to pay this bill as it covers our insurance


We have been asked to bring a meeting into the Coconino County Jail, but so far no addict has come forward to respond to the request.

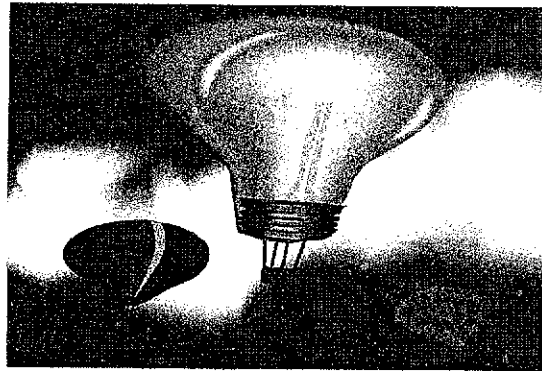


