## RCM II Report February 2012

To Phoenix Area Service Committee:

Region met on January 15 and this is my report:

- The treasurer of the region joined the RCM forum to inform us of where we are on our finances. Basically we have \$5,546.00 in bills and \$1,400 in our account. The RCM's decided to put an idea in to ask subcommittees to look at their budgets and reduce them by 40%. That reduction would be due back at the next region.
- Paul W. came to announce the ARCNA fund raiser in Tucson on 2/11 from 6-10pm. Donation \$5 Park ave and 4<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Mt. Lemmon Bash - If you would be willing to speak there submit your name to [na.tucson.org](http://na.tucson.org), they will select and if selected you could win a free registration
- The regional activities Chair has stepped down, resumes welcome for that position
- Region wants to know if we can reduce our meeting list's. Right now we get 2800 every other month. Region looking for areas to cut expenses
- The Phoenix area has agreed to host the CAR assembly in March. This past region we had to cut the food budget for the assembly to 0. People in that area stepped up and donated that meal for 60+. I am organizing the food for the March Assembly and would like to get homegroups involved in providing food for the event. It will save the region \$200.00. We can expect ~~70~~<sup>100</sup>+ people for that event.
- Insurance update- don't put Children's Activities on any of NA sponsored events. Please use the language Family Activities. Our insurance states that parents must stay with children.
- Regional Guideline committee is meeting Jan. 15. They will get the Web committee guidelines consistent with the rest of the subcommittees, they will also establish a procedure for storage and archiving. If you have any suggestions or comments on either of those processes, please contact Ken F. who will forward the questions to the committee.
- Treasurer report – Daniel listed the bills that needed to be paid and we had to decide what to pay. The bills were: BOD \$2765.50, H&I reimbursement for shipping lit. \$55.70, flyers for the March assembly(reimbursement) \$32.79, CAR \$39.99 Reimbursement), mileage 106.80, check for Car assembly rent \$250, January assembly food \$200 and the festival of

recovery asked for \$500. \$2875 donated this month, took a personal donation of \$135, paid out \$350.00 for mileage. The region paid the money that was a reimbursement, ½ the BOD payment 2765, Navapache RCMS reduced mileage reimbursement from 106 to 40. Food for assembly was eliminated and the festival of recovery reduced request to \$400. The region will have go thru this when we meet to decide what bills will get paid. Next region we have the other half of the BOD payment and the meeting lists which average \$916.30.

## Helpline Report 20120204

There were 550 calls in January, of which 30 were voice mail messages. One of the messages was from a legal firm requesting that we contact them regarding a subpoena for information on an individual whose name was unfamiliar. I talked to Sherwood about what we should do with this request, and his suggestion was to ignore it and see if they call back again. They've called back again. Personally, I don't want to be the legal face of NA in the community, so I'll forward the request to whoever this body decides.

We're still having problems uploading the new menu prompts to Accessline, and they assert it's because they're not in a compatible format. I guess the next step is to email a converted wav file to them so they can tell us what's wrong with it. Until this is resolved, we can't re-enable menu 9 for Tuesday morning. Jeff and Joanne are handling Tuesday daytime as a single 12 hour shift.

We have a few volunteers in queue for shifts and there are no shifts currently with less than two volunteers.

The Accessline bill in January was \$97.53, and the Century Link bill was \$58.97 for a total of \$156.50, or \$52.16 per area.

Budgets we due last month. If you want to keep it really simple, take the figures above and round up to the nearest even amount and multiply by 12 for an annual figure.  $\$160 * 12$  is \$1920, or \$640 per area. Of course, this means you're less likely to send the next helpline chairperson to WSLD, but that is consistent with the way this expense is handled in H&I – a separate motion (or idea) is required to request the funds three months prior to the event. This seems a little problematic, since WSLD is in September, and the new chairperson takes their seat in August. Anyway, there seems to be an opinion that if a committee's guidelines don't explicitly say it is the responsibility of the committee to send someone to WSLD, then they shouldn't. I didn't go last year with the understanding that any relevant information would be made available after the event. I'd like to point out that that didn't happen.

We will move our meetings to the 4th Monday of the month (that's February 27, 2012), at the Paradise Bakery at 12<sup>th</sup> St and Glendale. It's located on the southwest corner. We plan to meet at 7 p.m. Please join us if you can. We did have one new potential member join us last month.

- ✓ I have not heard back from JC Lincoln. They have the brochure. The brochure is designed to be given to addicts who are either admitted or come into the emergency room at the hospital, which refers them to NA. We await the administrator's approval but this may not occur for a few more months. I contacted the A Team at Maricopa Medical Center but to date have not heard back. I will call them again Monday.
- ✓ The public information day at Grand Canyon University's health and safety fair later this month; however, we had no one to staff it, so West Valley graciously agreed to do so. Lolo and Steven from West Valley did the fair and it went well. However, WE NEED PEOPLE WHO COULD PRESENT TO PROFESSIONALS DURING THE DAY! I can't stress enough how much more we could do with these human assets.
- ✓ We are planning a spring flyer day as part of the H&I picnic.
- ✓ We are still distributing *Basic Texts* and *It Works* distributed to halfway houses in Phoenix. So far they have been distributed to the federal halfway house on Roosevelt, Dignity Program, Calvary, Crossroads for Women and both TLCs.
- ✓ The best idea I have at this moment is to hold a Phoenix learning event for the media, nonprofits, and other social service agencies. We would find a central location (I'm thinking JC Lincoln's community center in Sunnyslope), invite the media and non profits, send out press releases, then hold a two-hour meet and greet with a "What is NA" presentation. I find in about one-third of the meetings I attend, parents and young people are present checking out NA. I think it's time for us to make an effective effort to cooperate with Naranon and invite them to participate in this event. In keeping with our Sixth Tradition, we would not "endorse" them, but merely allow a speaker from Naranon to present and to place their literature there, as well. I will meet with Rose, the Regional PR rep, to see how the region can support this. Also, the region wants each Phoenix area to have its own set up for our own booths because logistically it is too hard to move the booth (I think it's just big poster boards with NA stuff on them but I've never seen it) between areas. I soon have every other Monday off work so will begin working on this in earnest in February.
- ✓ We present a PR presentation to the City of Phoenix Parks & Rec department in Sunnyslope. They work with at-risk youths and have a lot of need for information, especially for parents. We anticipate a lot of Spanish-speaking parents and want one Spanish-speaking addict to share his or her ES&H. There is now a regional projector; so will work with region to see how we can perhaps find someone with one.
- ✓ West Valley is printing the NA business cards now with Spanish on the back of the cards for the same price.
